

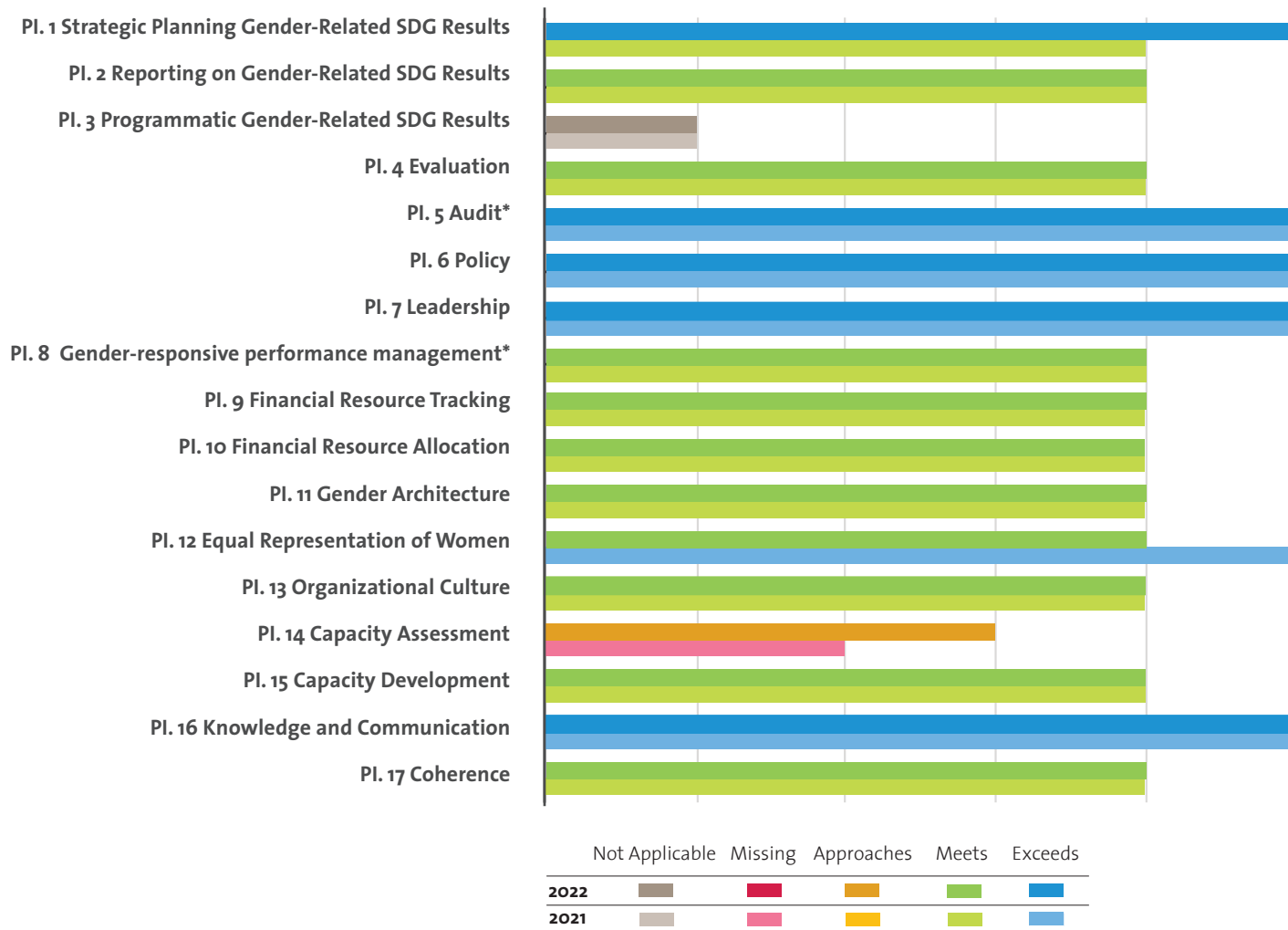

Most significant gains

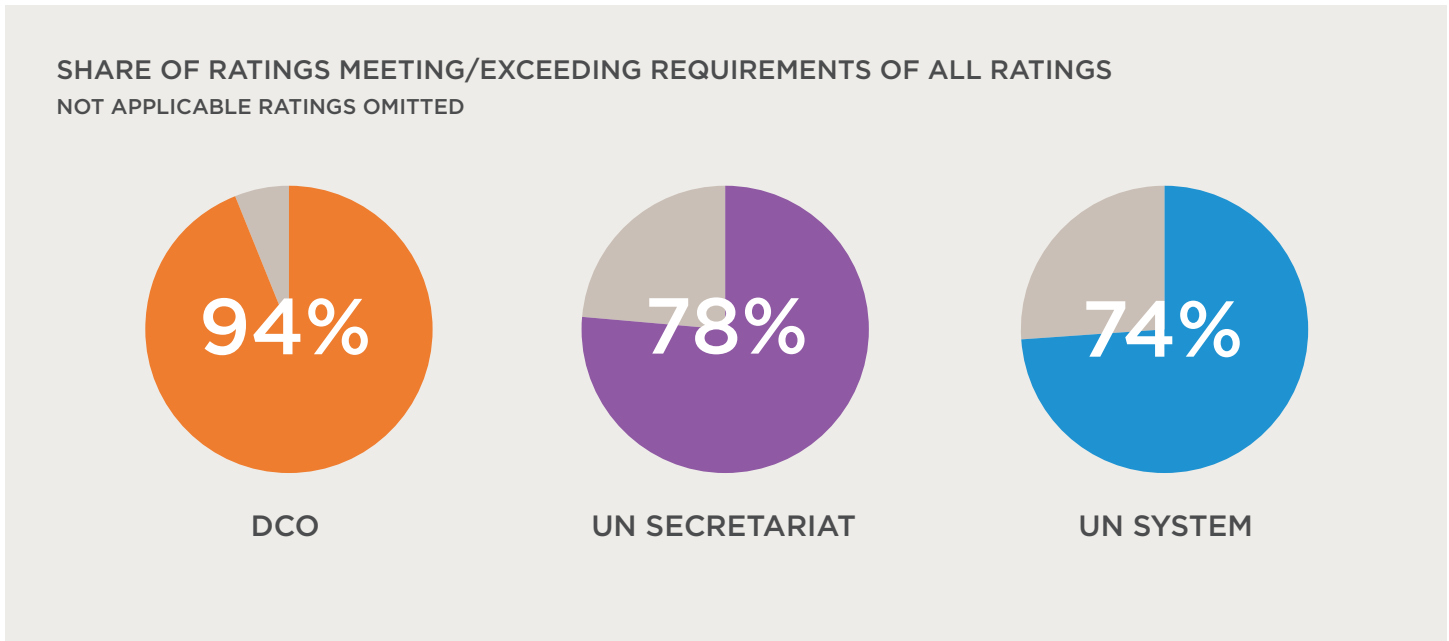
- In 2022, DCO met the requirements for ten indicators and exceeded the requirements for another five indicators.
- DCO improved performance across two performance indicators, Strategic Planning Gender-related results and Capacity Assessment.

Areas for improvement

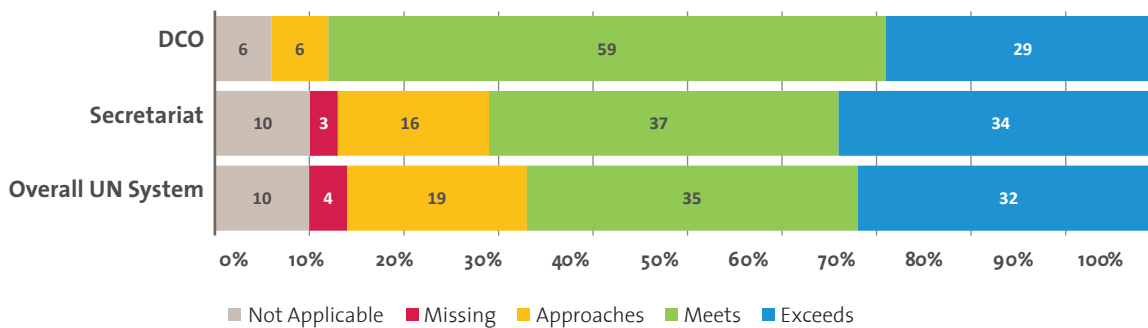
- DCO is encouraged to continue its efforts to strengthen gender related capacity assessment to achieve full UN-SWAP compliance.

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR DCO

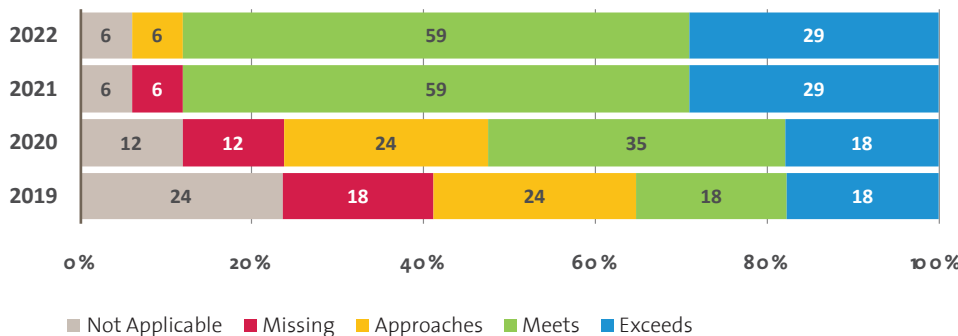


COMPARISON WITH THE SECRETARIAT AS A WHOLE AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM
