

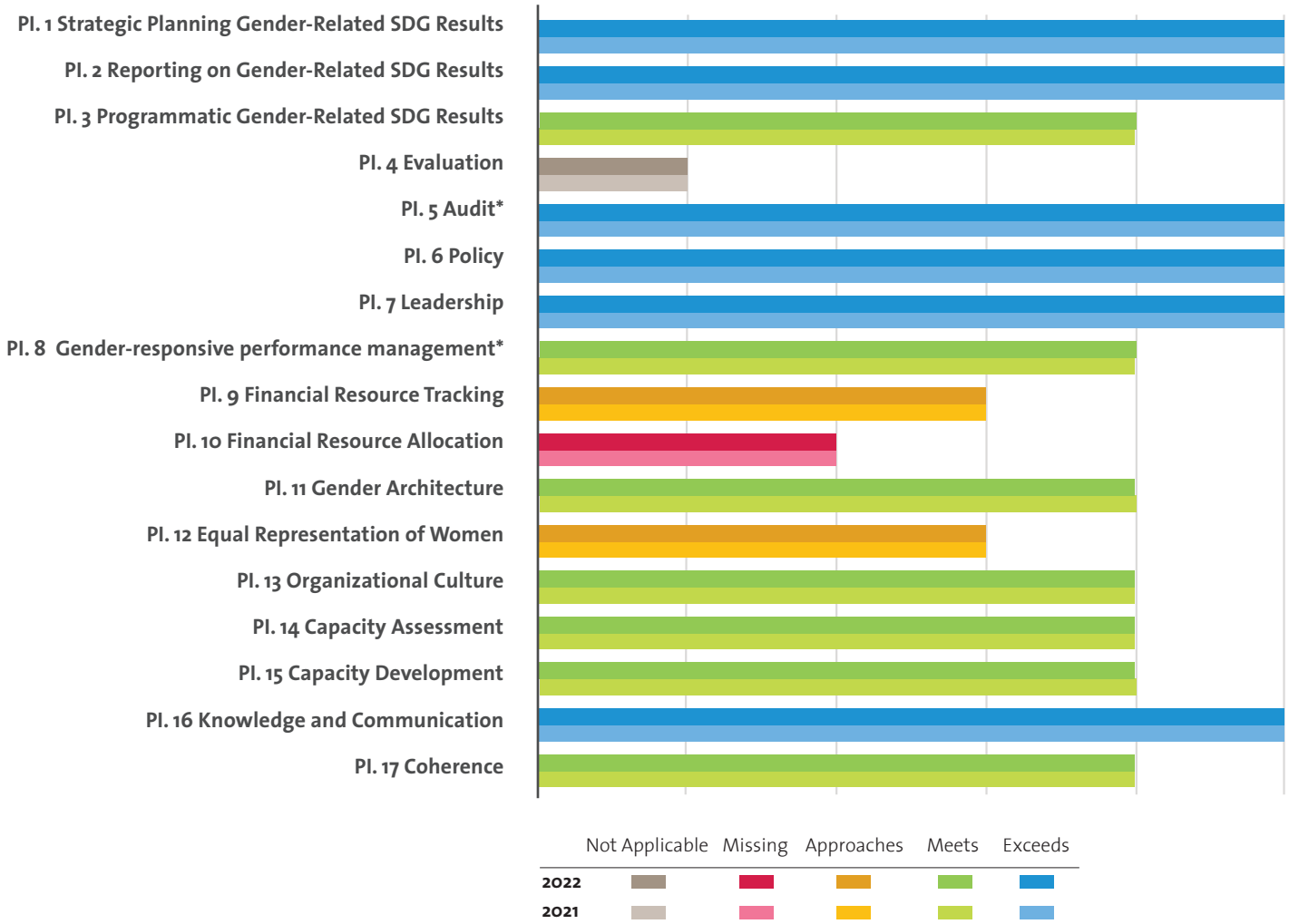

Most significant gains

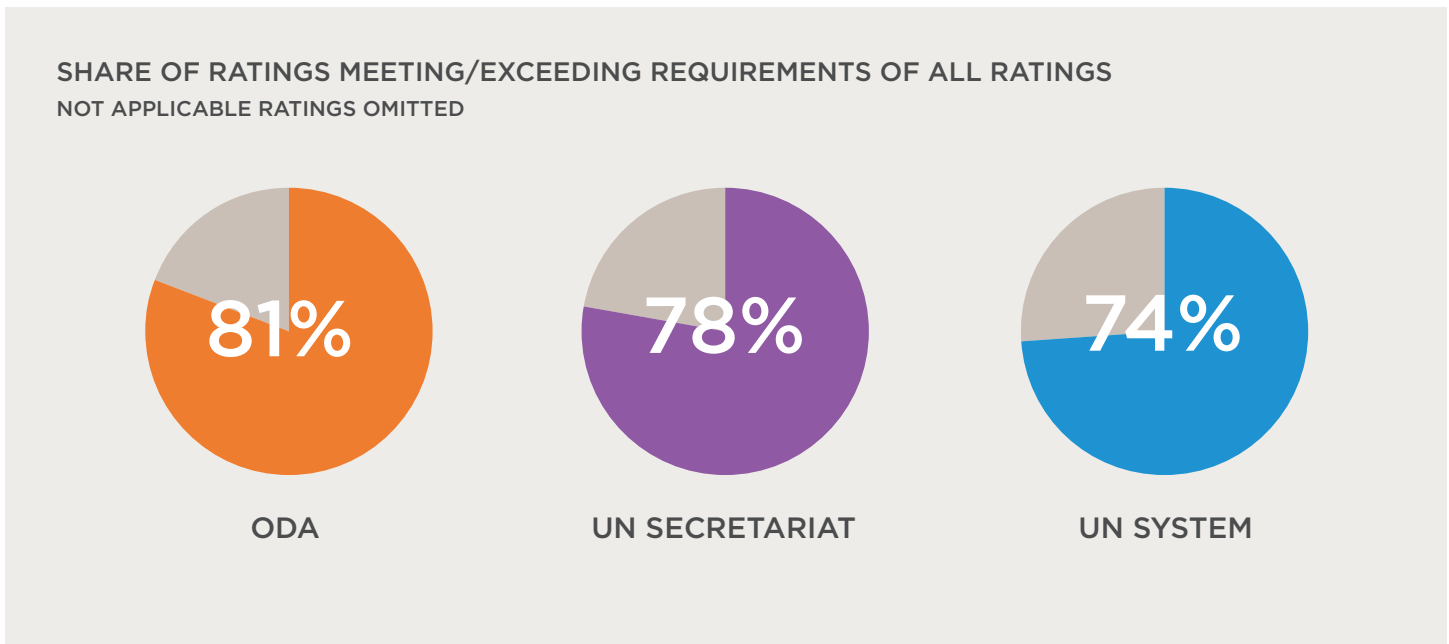
- In 2022, ODA exceeded the requirements for six indicators and met them for another seven indicators.

Areas for improvement

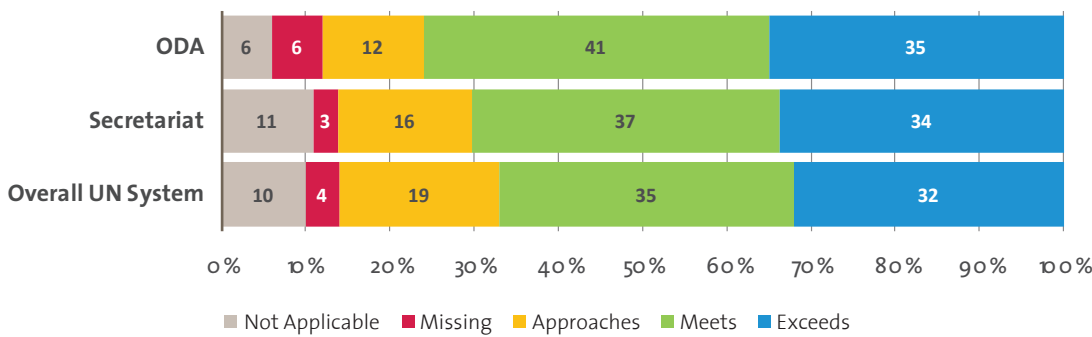

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR ODA

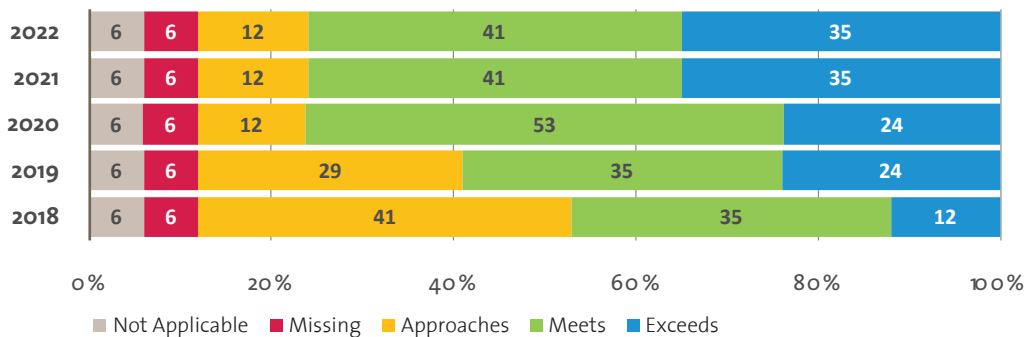


COMPARISON WITH THE SECRETARIAT AS A WHOLE AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM
