

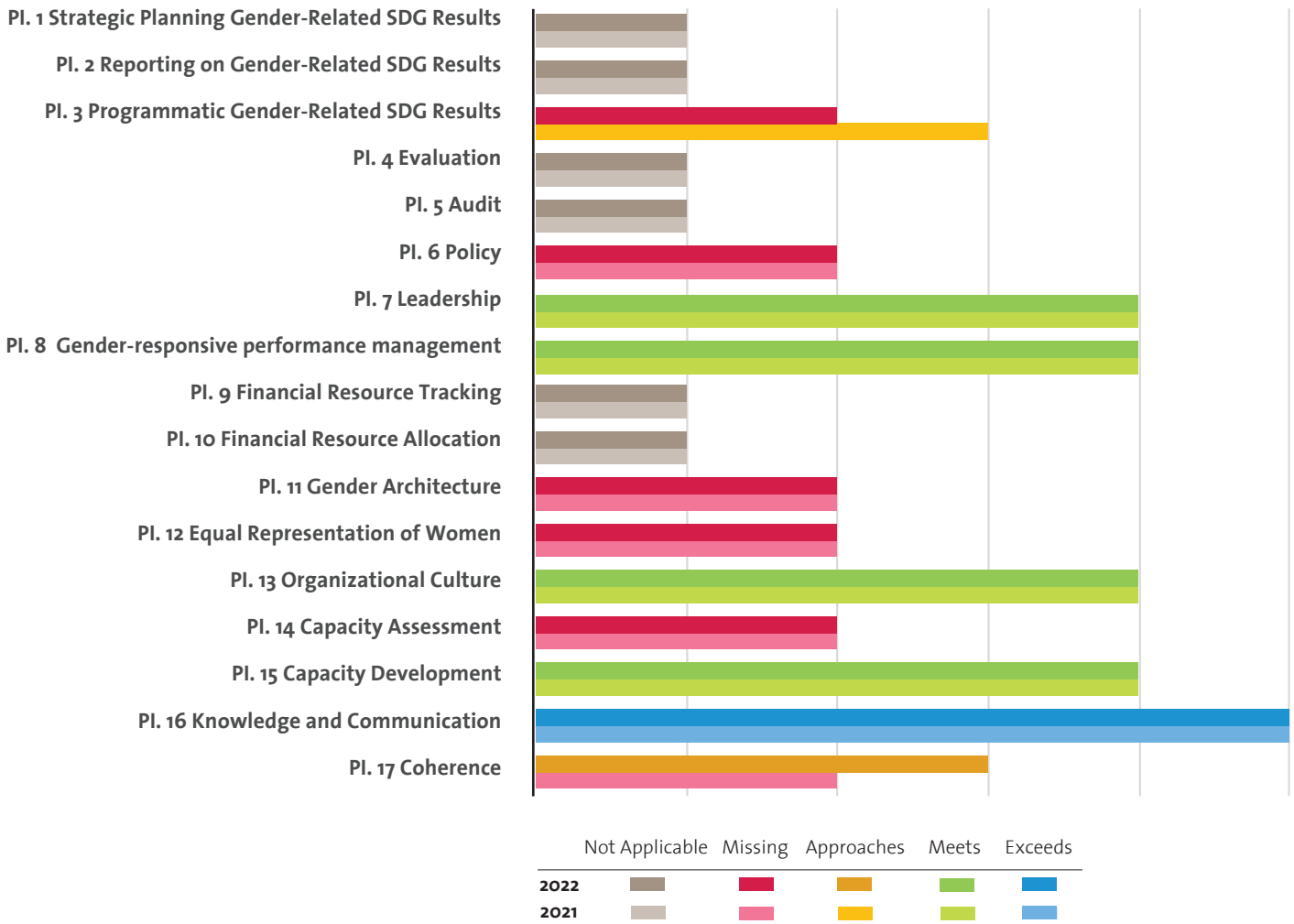

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2022

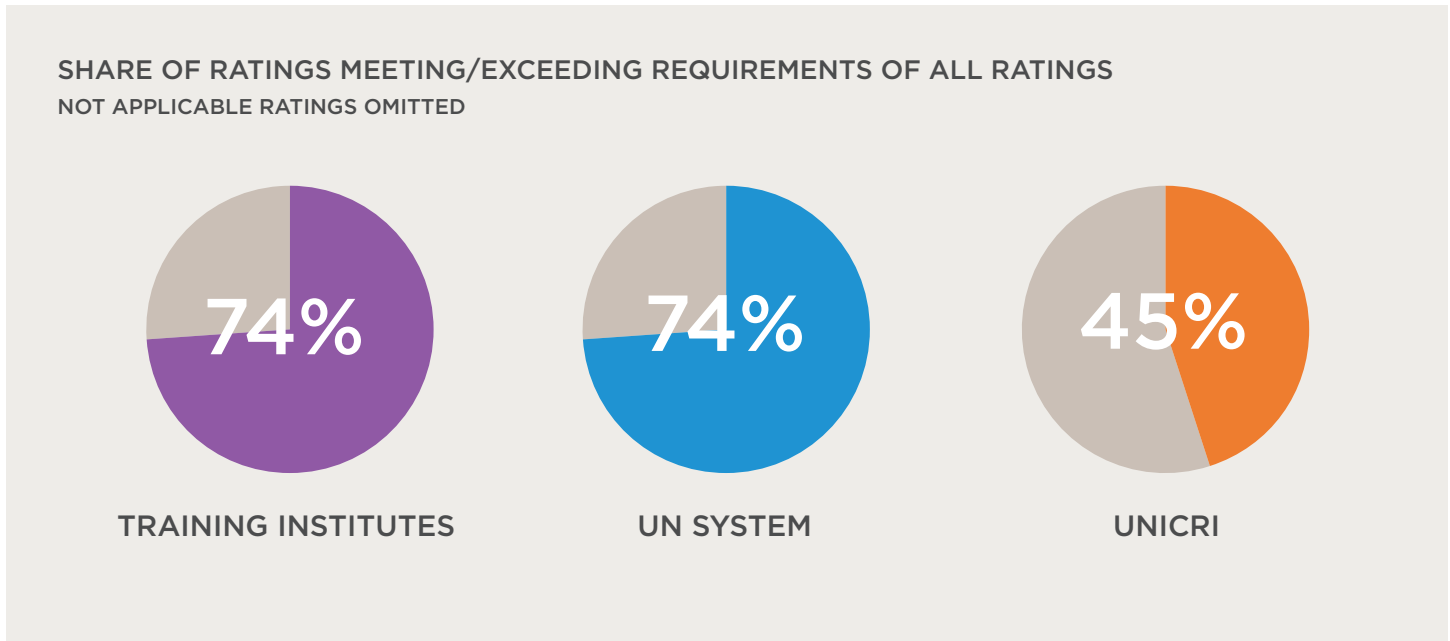
Most significant gains

- In 2022, UNICRI exceeded the requirements for one indicator and met them for another four indicators.
- Importantly, UNICRI progressed from missing to approaching requirements in the area of Coherence.

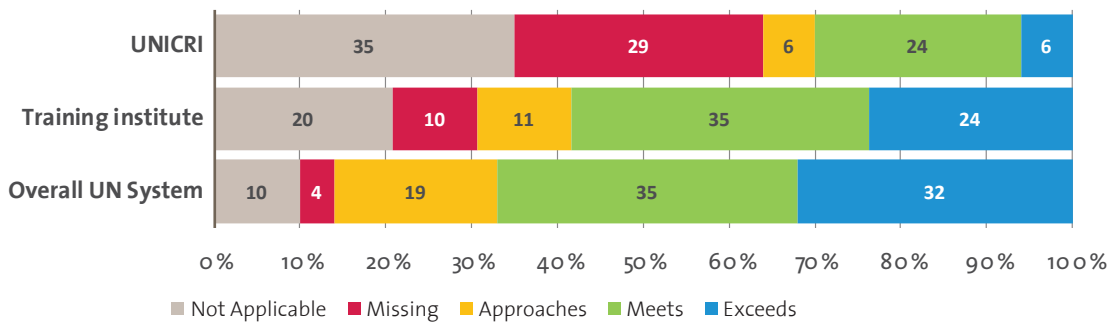
Areas for improvement

- UN Women encourages UNICRI to focus on the five indicators rated as missing requirements.
- In particular, UNICRI is encouraged to reclaim lost gains in the area of Programmatic gender-related SDG results.
- UNICRI is encouraged to finalize its gender equality policy. The development of a comprehensive Gender Equality Policy will help drive progress across several areas.

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR UNICRI



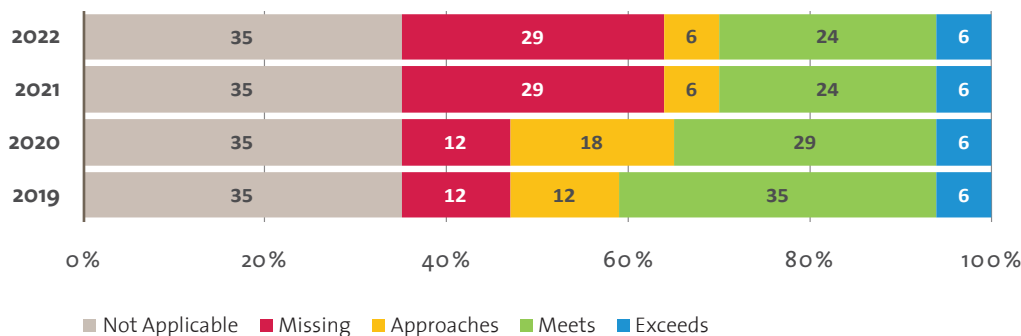
COMPARISON WITH SPECIALIZED ENTITIES AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM



In 2022, UNICRI's UN-SWAP 2.0 results trailed the average results of Training institutes and the overall UN system.

Comparatively, UNICRI rated a larger share of indicators as not applicable or missing requirements than similar entities or the UN system as a whole.

UNICRI, COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF RATINGS BY YEAR



UNICRI matched the performance achieved in 2021, meeting or exceeding significantly less indicators than in the first years of reporting.
