

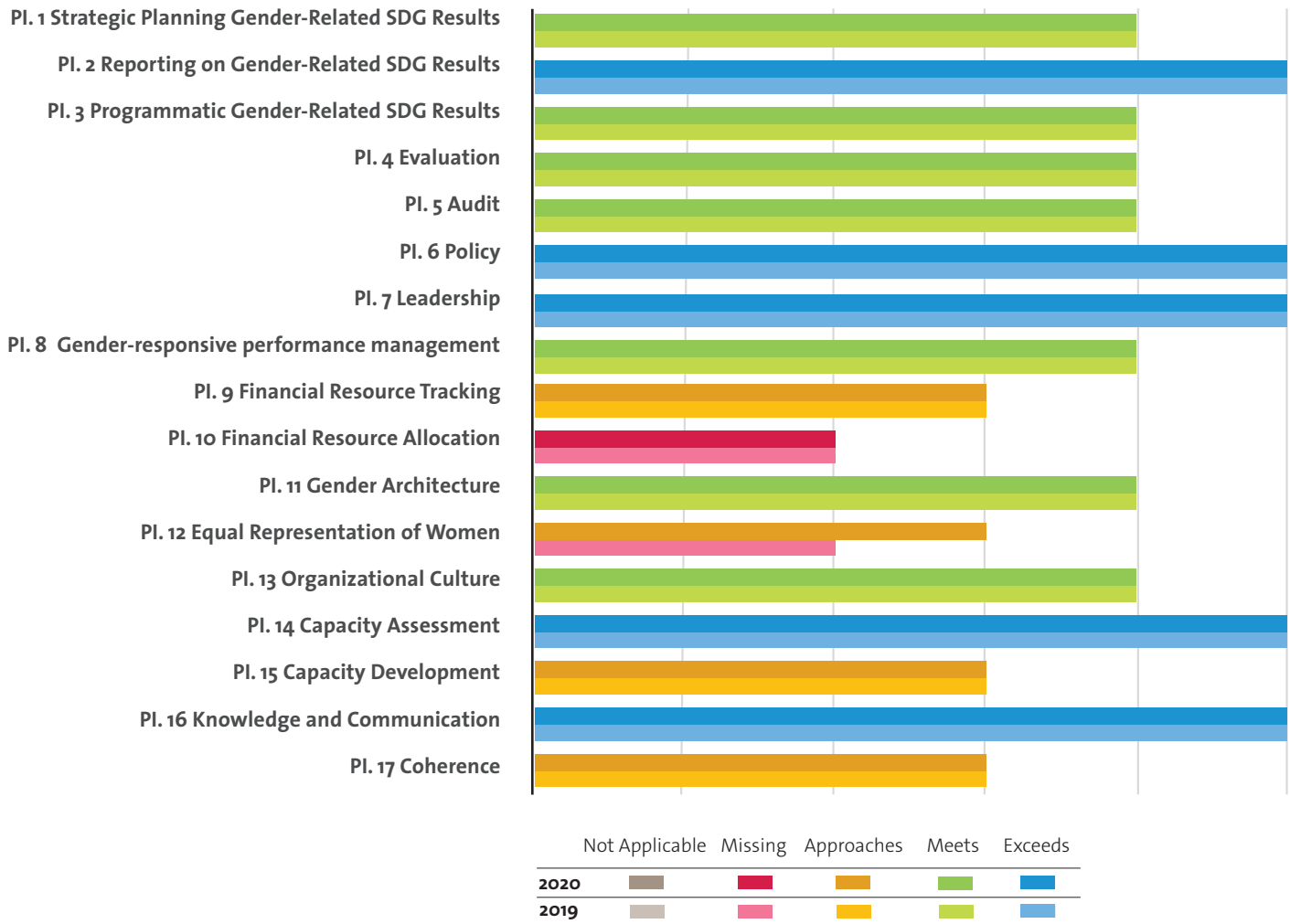

In 2020, IAEA met or exceeded the requirements for 12 performance indicators out of 17 applicable, maintaining 2019 performance.

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2020

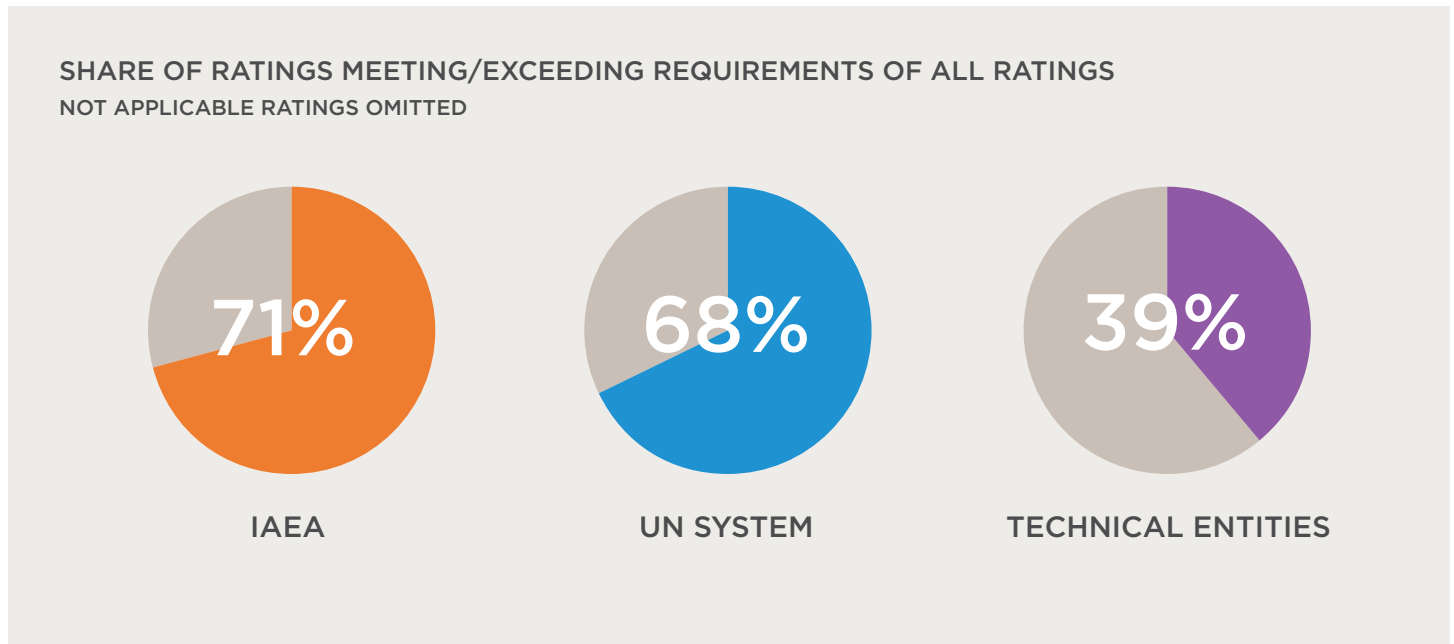
Most significant gains

- In 2020, IAEA exceeded requirements on five indicators and met them for another seven indicators.
- IAEA improved performance this year on the Equal Representation of Women by approaching requirements.

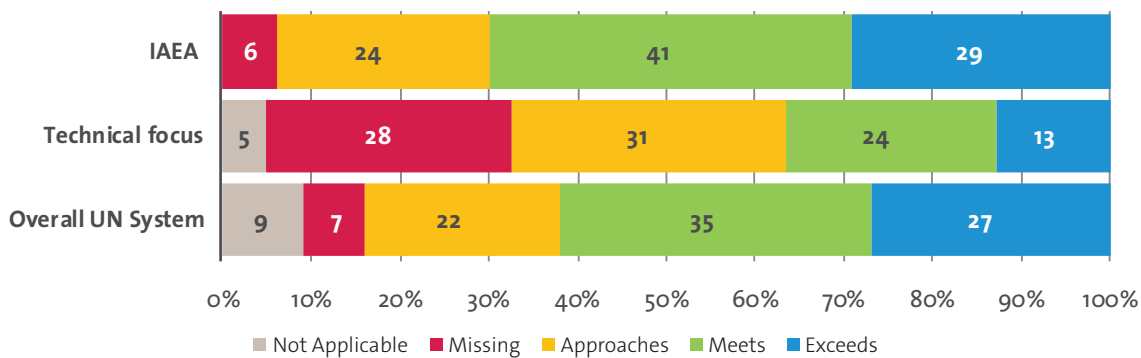
Areas for improvement

- UN Women encourages IAEA to focus on Financial Resource Allocation, the only performance indicator that is missing requirements.
- UN Women also recommends focusing on the four indicators rated as approaching requirements in order to drive overall progress towards gender equality at IAEA.

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR IAEA

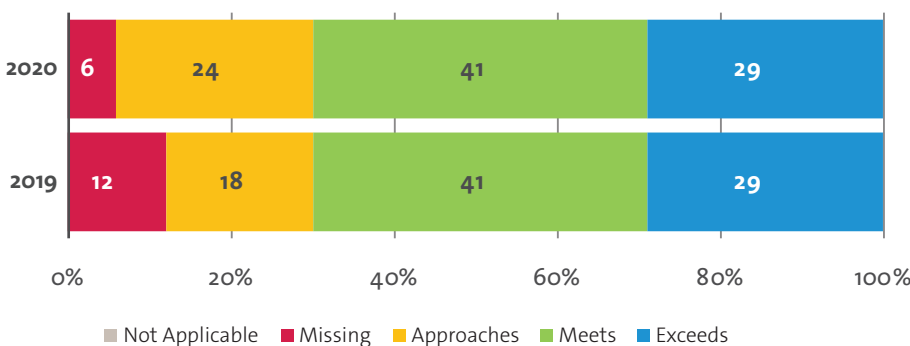


COMPARISON WITH TECHNICAL ENTITIES AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM



- In 2020, IAEA met and exceeded significantly more indicators other technical entities and trailed ahead of the average for the UN System as a whole.
- IAEA rated significantly less indicators as missing than the average for technical entities.

IAEA, COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF RATINGS BY YEAR



- In 2020, IAEA maintained its overall strong performance by meeting and exceeding the same number of indicators as in 2019.
- IAEA is now missing requirements for only one indicator, having improved performance from missing to approaching requirements on the Equal Representation of Women.
