

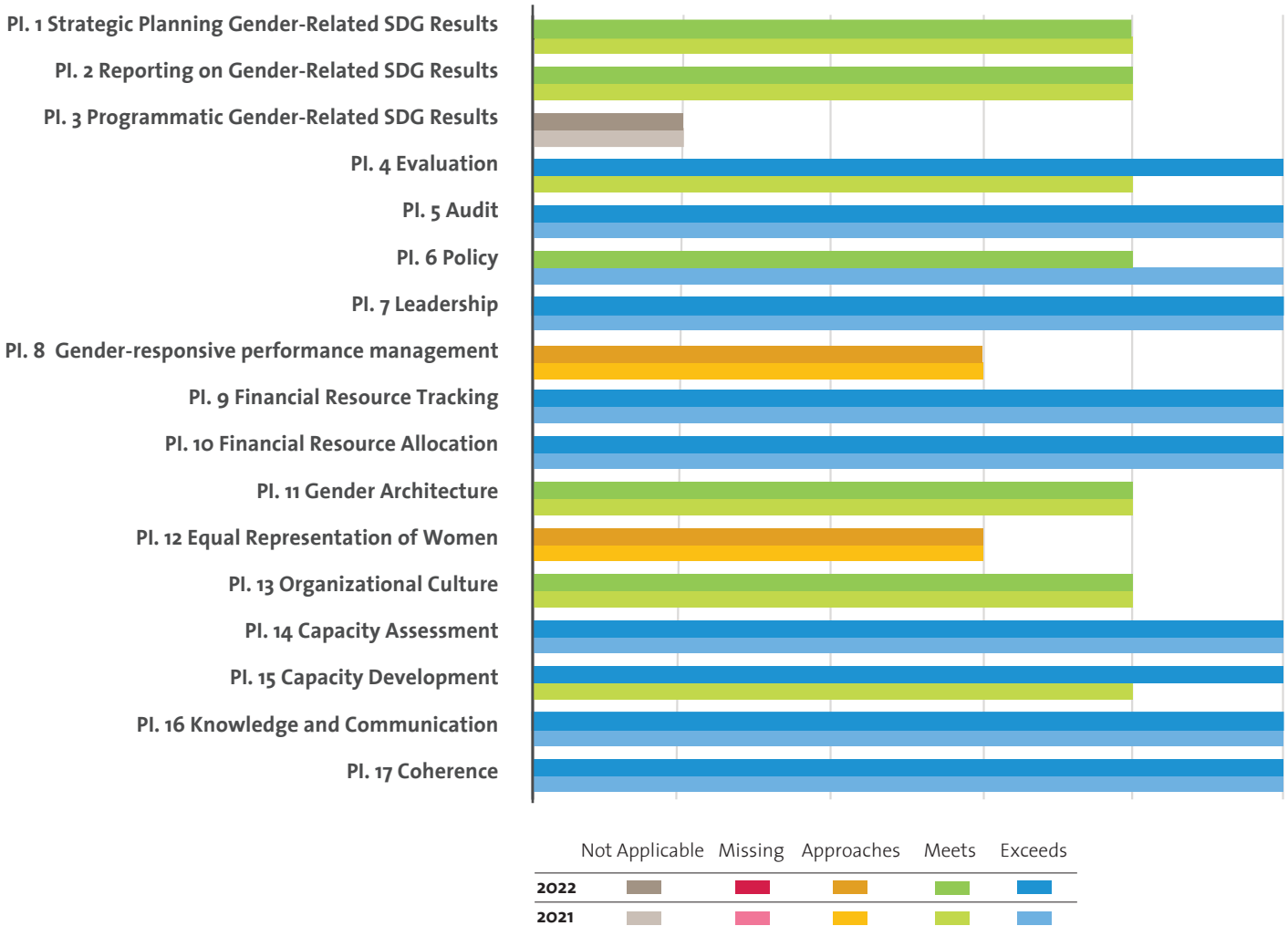

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2022

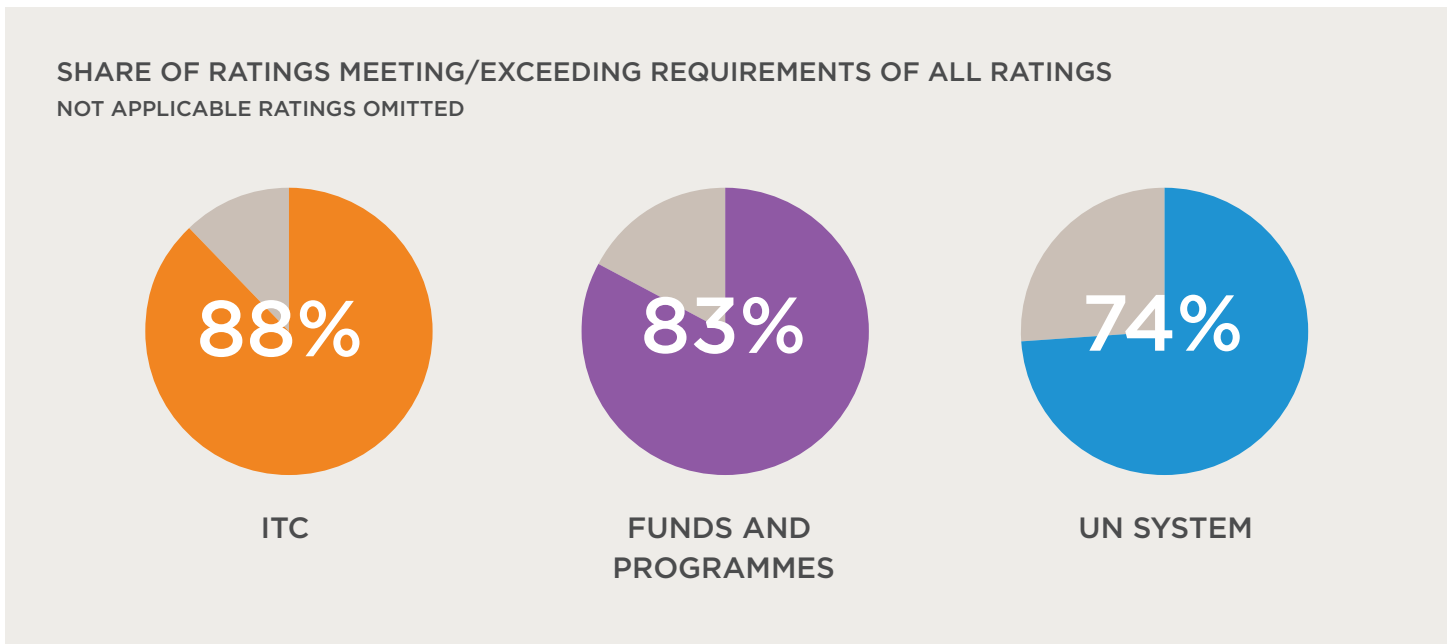
Most significant gains

- In 2022, ITC exceeded requirements for nine indicators and met requirements for five indicators.
- Significantly, ITC newly exceeded requirements for the Evaluation and Capacity development performance indicators.

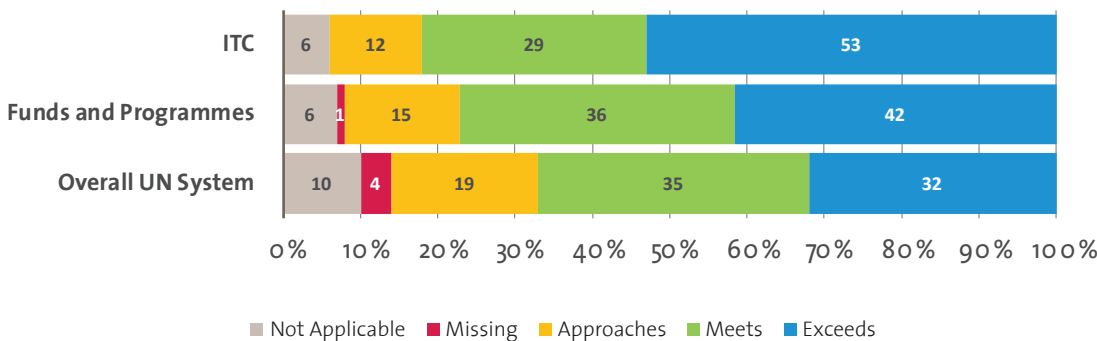
Areas for improvement

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR ITC

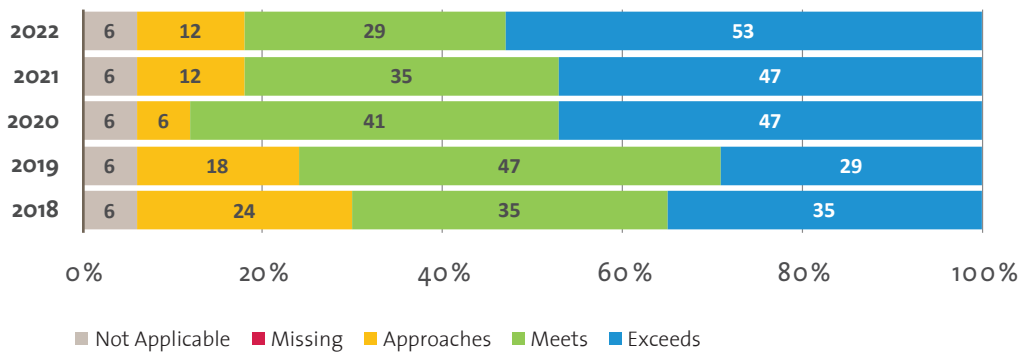


COMPARISON WITH THE FUNDS AND PROGRAMMES AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM
