

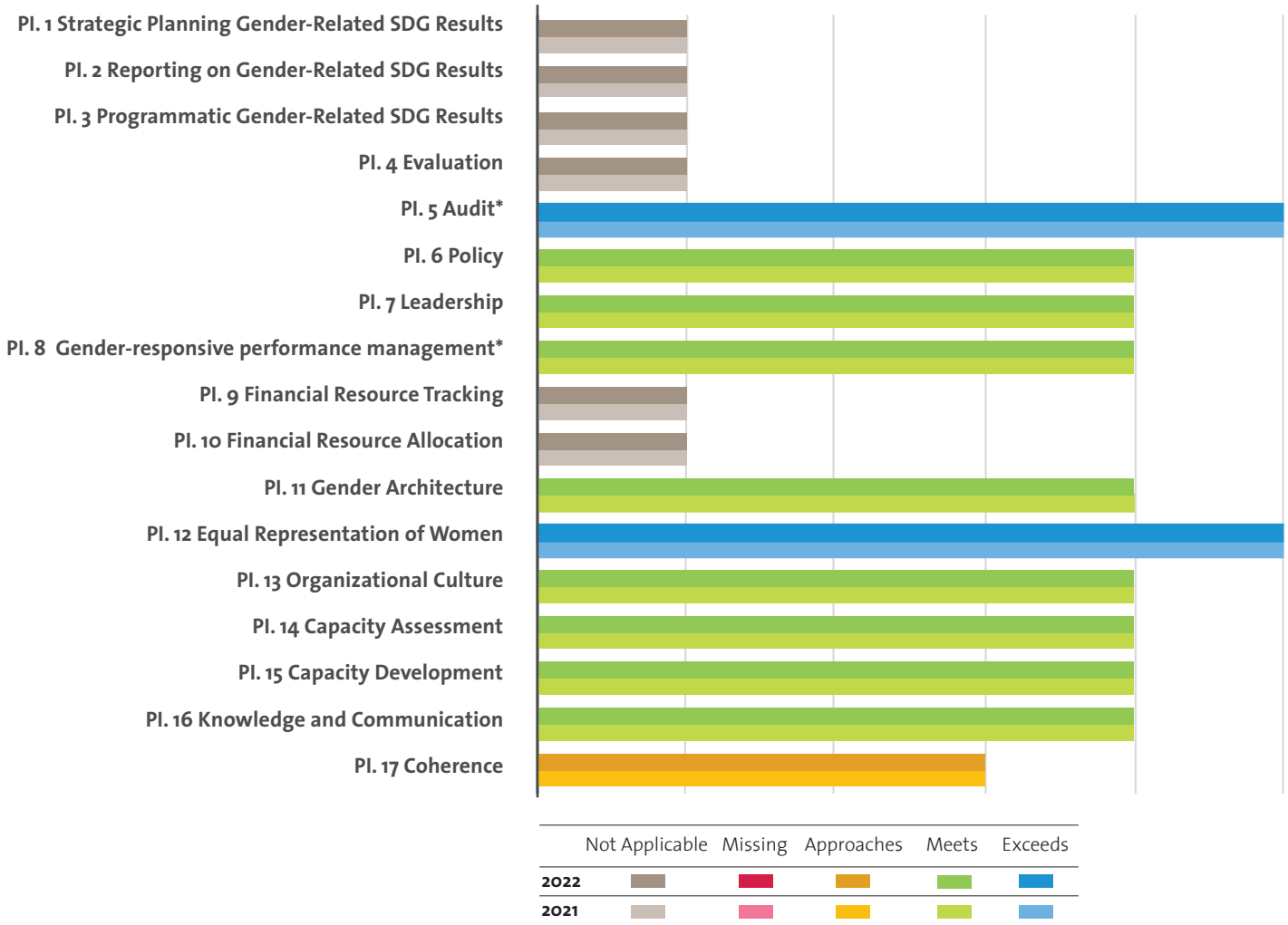

Most significant gains

- In 2022, OAJ exceeded the requirements for two indicators and met them for another eight indicators.

Areas for improvement

- UN Women encourages OAJ to engage in a peer review with another UN-SWAP reporting entity to meet the requirements for the final indicator approaching requirements, Coherence.

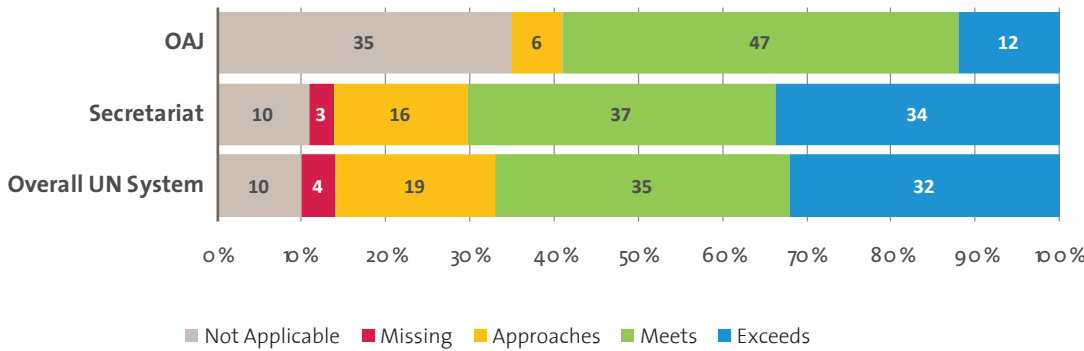

NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED



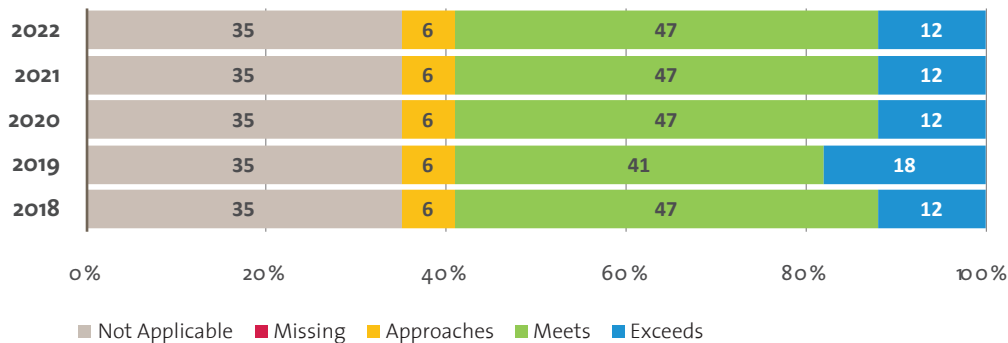
COMPARISON WITH THE UN SECRETARIAT AS A WHOLE AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM



In 2022, OAJ outperformed the average results for the UN Secretariat as a whole and for the UN System at large.

OAJ did not miss the requirements for any indicators. However, significantly more indicators were assessed as not applicable.
