

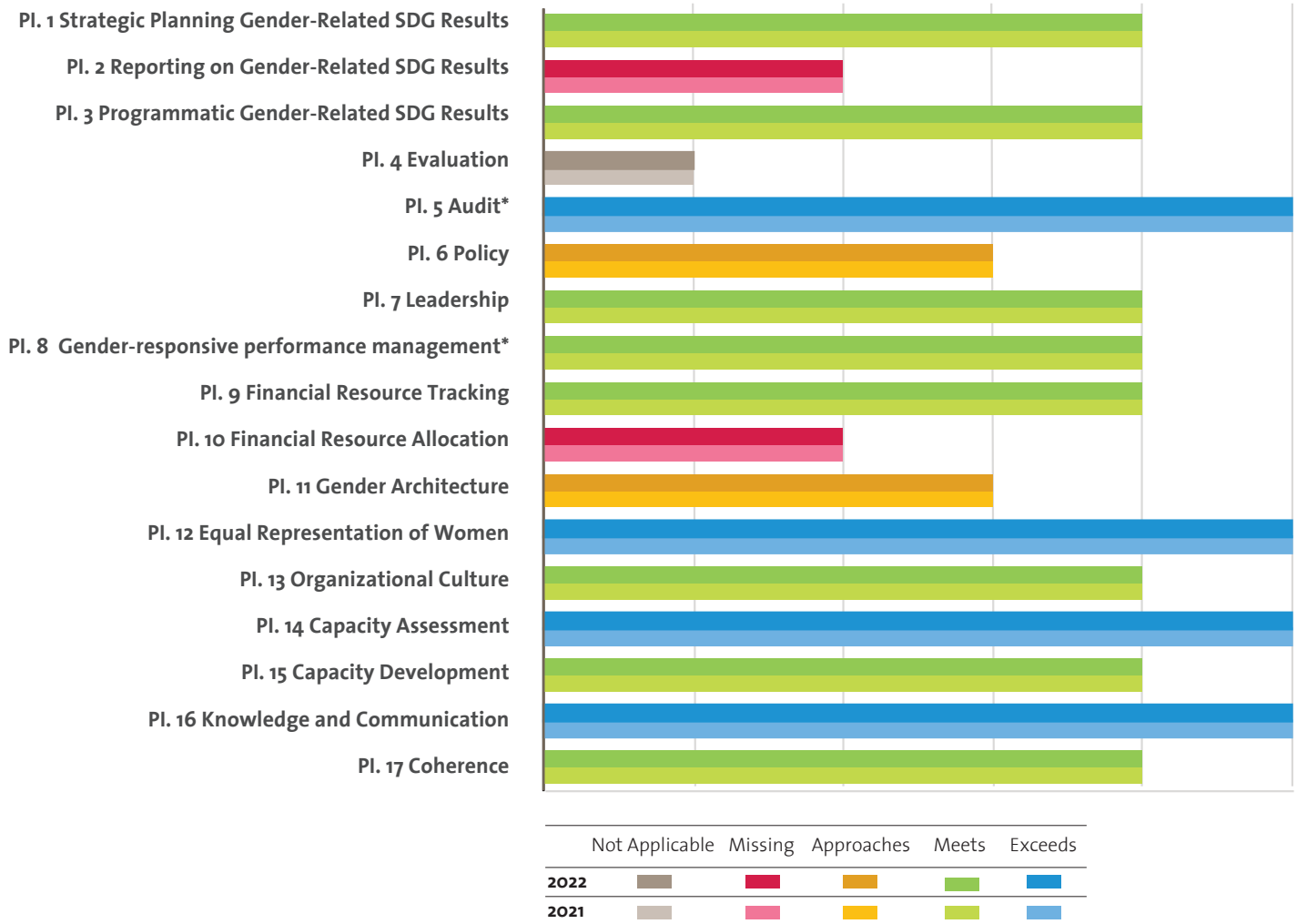

## UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2022

The following three pages capture the UN Global Compact's performance on UN-SWAP 2.0 indicators for 2022.

In 2022, the UN Global Compact met or exceeded the requirements for 12 out of 16 applicable performance indicators.

#### PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2022

##### Most significant gains

- In 2022, the UN Global Compact exceeded the requirements for four indicators and met them for another eight indicators.

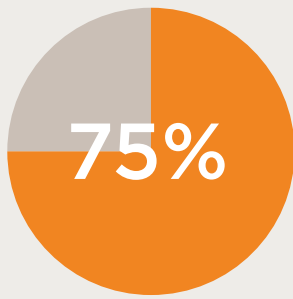
##### Areas for improvement

- UN Women encourages renewed focus on the two indicators rated as missing: Reporting on gender related SDG results and Financial resource allocation.
- Likewise, UN Global Compact is encouraged to focus on the two indicators rated as approaching, Gender architecture and Policy. These two indicators have shown to positively impact overall UN-SWAP 2.0 progress.

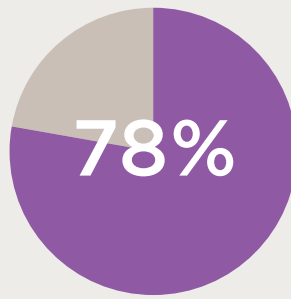

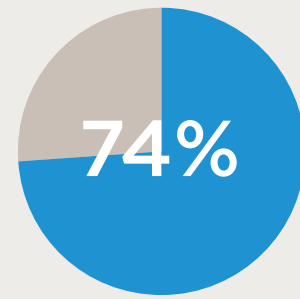
SHARE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS OF ALL RATINGS

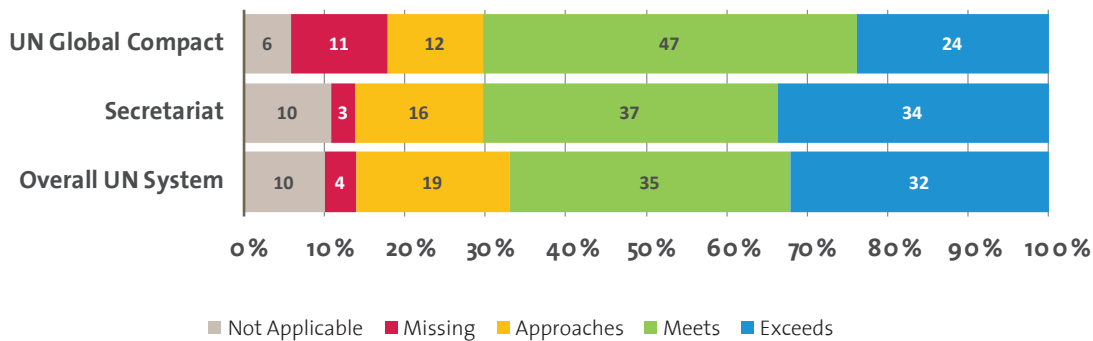

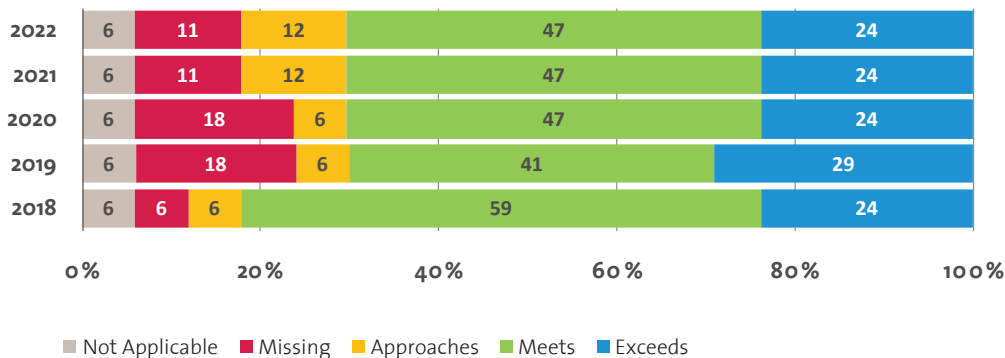
## COMPARISON WITH THE SECRETARIAT AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM



In 2022, the UN Global Compact met and exceeded a similar share of indicators as the average results of the Secretariat and of the UN System as a whole.

Despite an overall strong performance the UN Global Compact missed requirements for significantly more indicators comparatively.
