Most significant gains

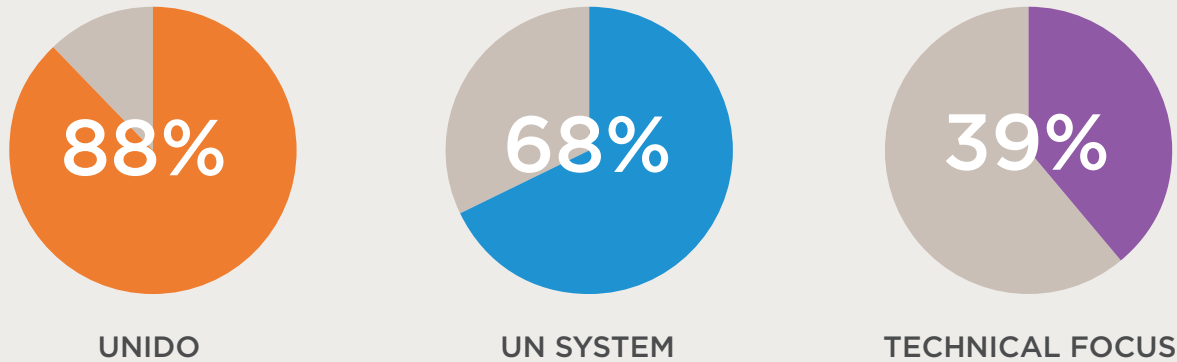
- In 2020, UNIDO exceeded requirements for nine indicators and met them for another six indicators.
- UNIDO has improved performance this year by exceeding requirements on Coherence and meeting requirements on Programmatic gender-related SDG results.

Areas for improvement

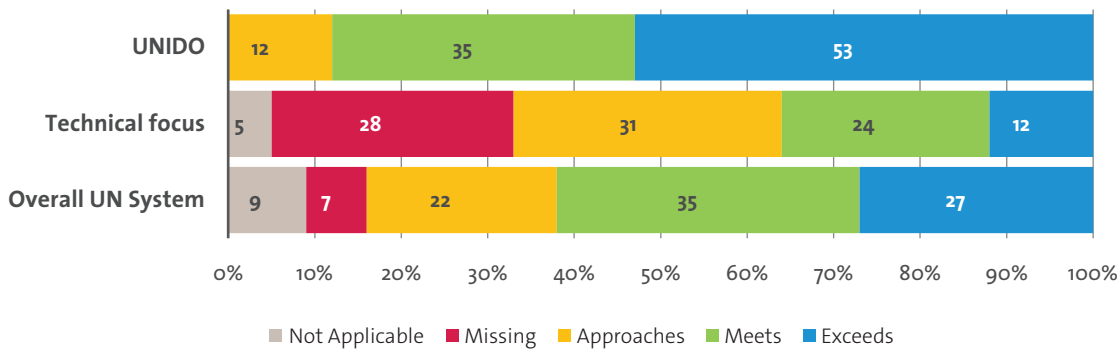
- UN Women encourages UNIDO to focus on the two remaining indicators rated as approaching requirements: Evaluation and Equal representation of women.

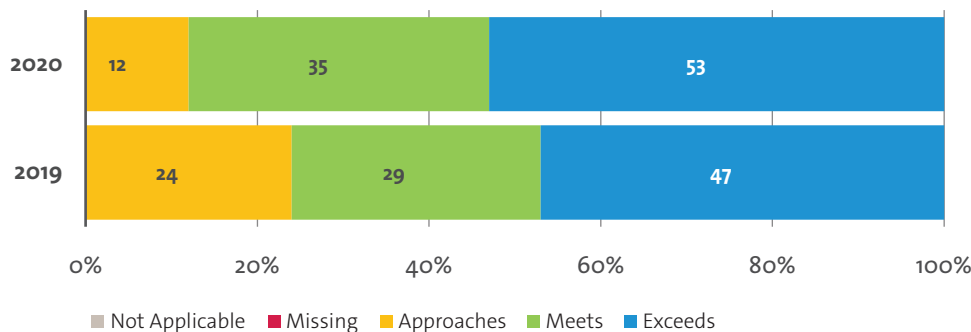


COMPARISON WITH SPECIALIZED ENTITIES AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM



- In 2020, UNIDO met and exceeded significantly more indicators than the average for Technical entities and the UN System as a whole.
- In addition, UNIDO did not rate any indicators as missing or not applicable.

UNIDO, COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF RATINGS BY YEAR



- In 2020, UNIDO met or exceeded the requirements for 88 per cent of the indicators, a 12-percentage point increase from 2019.
