### women Management Response

Recommendations inform development of Flagship Programmes for Women's Economic Empowerment (WEE FPs). Includes:

- Demand and supply side linkages couched in enabling environment (includes macroeconomic space)
- UN Women-'s coordination mandate for UN entity partnerships;
  Women's Empowerment Principles with corporations;
- Deeper integration of rights-based approach
- Leadership returned to Economic Empowerment Section
- Knowledge management and propagation through EmpowerWomen.org
