

WOMEN The Executive Board roles and responsibilities

- The EB role is set within the overall framework of policies formulated by the General Assembly, and the Economic and Social Council.
- The EB functions:
 - Receiving information from and give guidance to the Executive
 Director
 - Overseeing the Entity operational and coordination activities
 - Approving UN-Women overall governing documents:
 Strategic Plan, Integrated Budget, audit reports, evaluation plans and policies; and other managerial and policy documents.
 - Providing inter-governmental support to UN-Women leadership

- Interface between Member States and UN-Women and focal point for Executive Board matters
- Provide assistance and information to the Bureau to fulfill its mandates

- Maintain repository of decisions of the Executive Board

41 members across regions & donors who serve on a rotating basis:

- 10 from the Group of African States
- 10 from the Group of Asia-Pacific States
- 4 from the Group of Eastern European States
- 6 from the Group of Latin American and Caribbean States
- 5 from the Group of Western European and Other States (unique rotation scheme)
- 6 from contributing countries

Each member is elected by the Economic and Social Council for a term of three years.

The Executive Boards of UNDP/UNFPA/UNOPS, UNICEF, UN-Women and WFP engage in a **Joint Meeting of the Boards (JMB)** every year. The organization and coordination of the Joint Meeting of the Boards rotates each year between the 6 agencies, and this year **UNICEF** is the coordinating agency.

The **purpose** is to have a forum for the Executive Boards to discuss issues of common interest. It is a one-day meeting led by the four Presidents of the respective Executive Boards, with panel discussions devoted to one topic in the morning, and one topic in the afternoon. The discussions are chaired by the Presidents, with key roles for the principals of the six agencies.

The **outcome** of the JMB is not formalized, as the JMB is not a decision-making body.

The **report** of the JMB is a compilation of the proceedings by the Board secretariats. The report then goes to the respective Boards, who consider or take action on it as they deem appropriate.

- The **purpose** of the Joint Field Visit of the Executive Boards of UNDP/UNFPA/UNOPS, UNICEF, UN-Women and WFP is to help members of the Executive Boards to understand the extent and ways in which United Nations organizations contribute to the achievement of national development plans and global United Nations programmes.
- **Participation** should, in general, be limited to one member from each Executive Board from each regional group, plus representatives of the secretariats of UNDP/UNFPA/UNOPS, UNICEF, WFP, and UN-Women for a total of no more than 20 persons.
- The team will prepare a single joint report on the visit, which will be presented to the three Executive Boards.
