# Implementation Status of recommendations assigned to UN Women for action

#### 40 recommendations were assigned to UN Women for action


- 29 recommendations (73%) assigned to the Executive Head
- 11 recommendations (27%) assigned to the Governing Body or Member States

- 19 recommendations (48%) have been implemented
- 5 recommendations (13%) are in progress
- 16 recommendations (40%) are under consideration
