

## UN-Women Executive Board Informal Regional Briefing UN Secretariat. Conf. Room 12 21 June, 2019

The informal regional briefing to the Executive Board are being organized to increase awareness of UN-Women's work in an interactive way that speaks to results and opportunities, challenges and lessons learned.
