New action on women's rights - shared responsibilities

The Vision of Beijing Platform for Action is to promote human rights principles, power-sharing between women and men and overcoming oppressing structures and stereotypes. The women's movement in five Nordic countries, united at Nordiskt Forum in Malmö, Sweden, June 2014, took stock of new developments, progress and set-backs over the past 20 years, and agreed on future actions and demands at national, regional and international level.
