Dr. Diane Elson is a professor in the Department of Sociology and the Human Rights Centre at the University of Essex in the United Kingdom. She worked with UNIFEM in the conceptualization of its Biennial Review, Progress of the World's Women and was the coordinator of *UNIFEM's Progress of the World's Women 2000*. She is the principal author of *Progress of the World's Women 2002: Volume 2: Gender Equality and the Millennium Development Goals*.
