

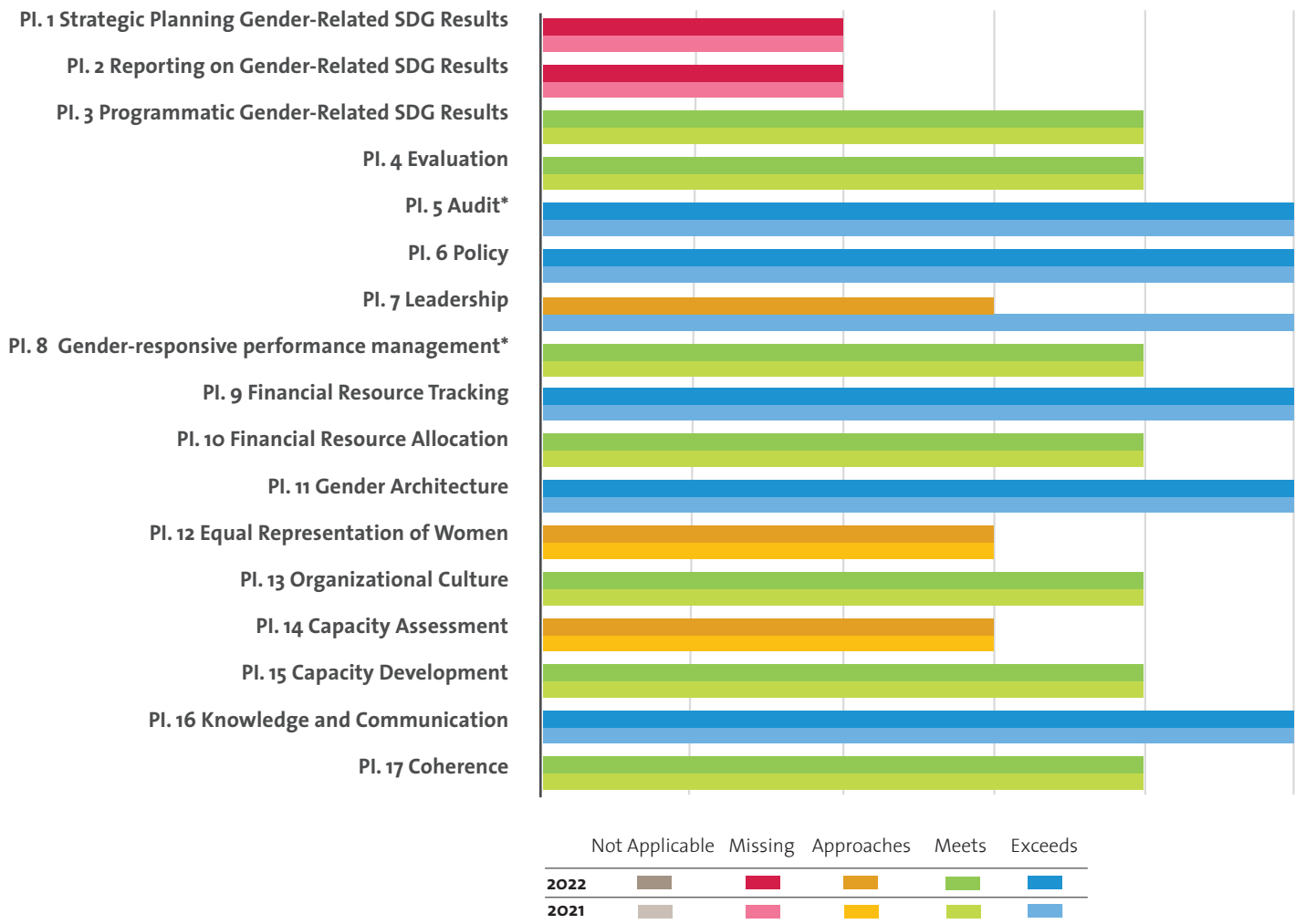

Most significant gains

- In 2022, OCHA exceeded requirements for five indicators and met them for another seven indicators.

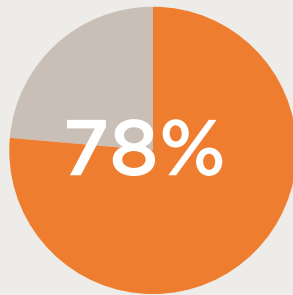
Areas for improvement

- UN Women encourages OCHA to focus on the five indicators missing or approaching requirements: Strategic planning, Reporting on gender-related SDG results, Leadership, Equal representation of women and Capacity assessment.

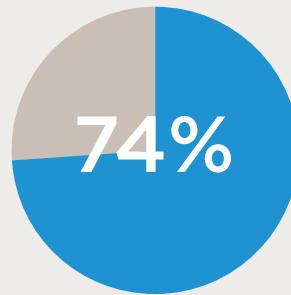

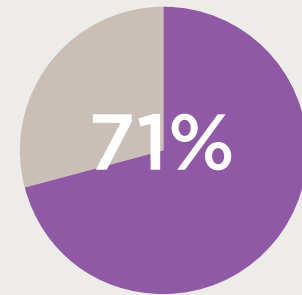
SHARE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS OF ALL RATINGS

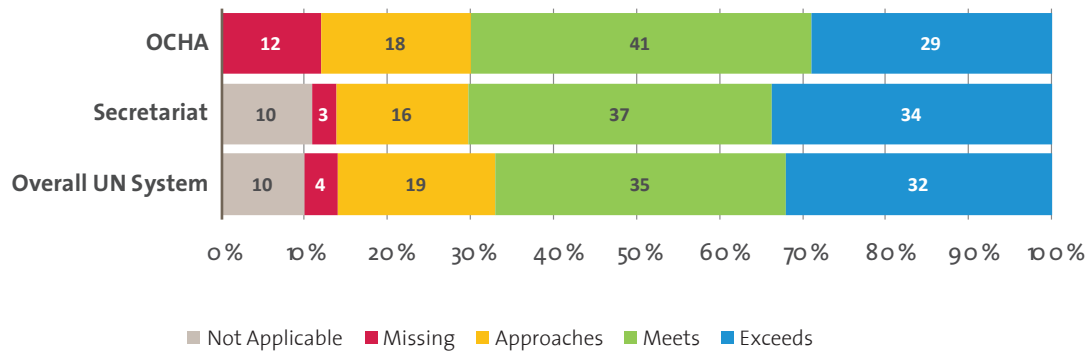

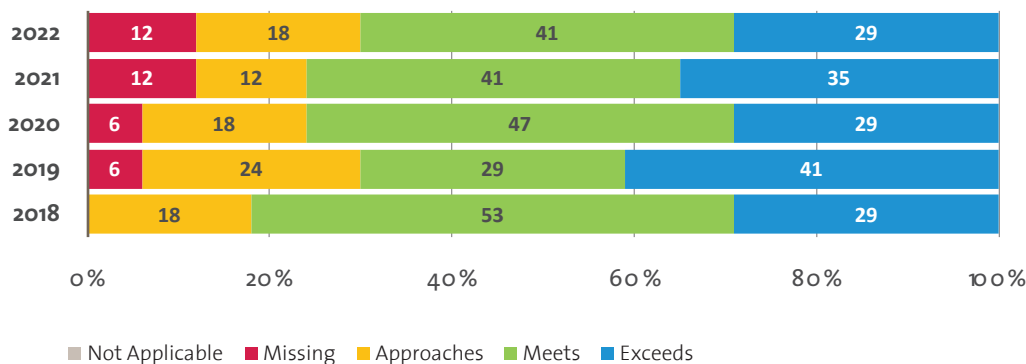
COMPARISON WITH SECRETARIAT ENTITIES AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM



In 2022, OCHA met or exceeded a similar share of indicators as the average of the Secretariat entities and UN system as a whole.

Comparatively, OCHA missed more indicator requirements. However, OCHA rated all 17 indicators as applicable to their scope of work.
