

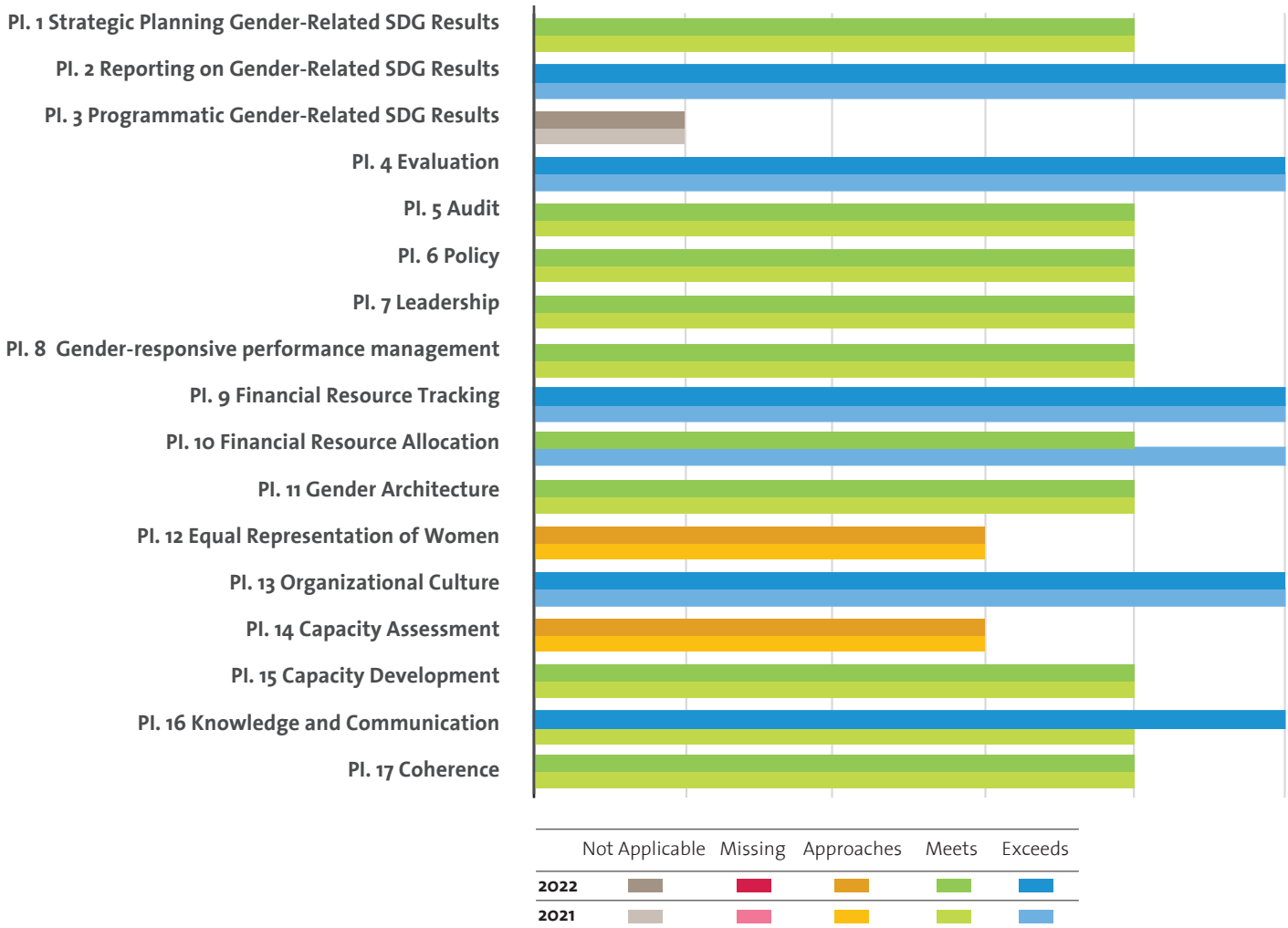

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2022

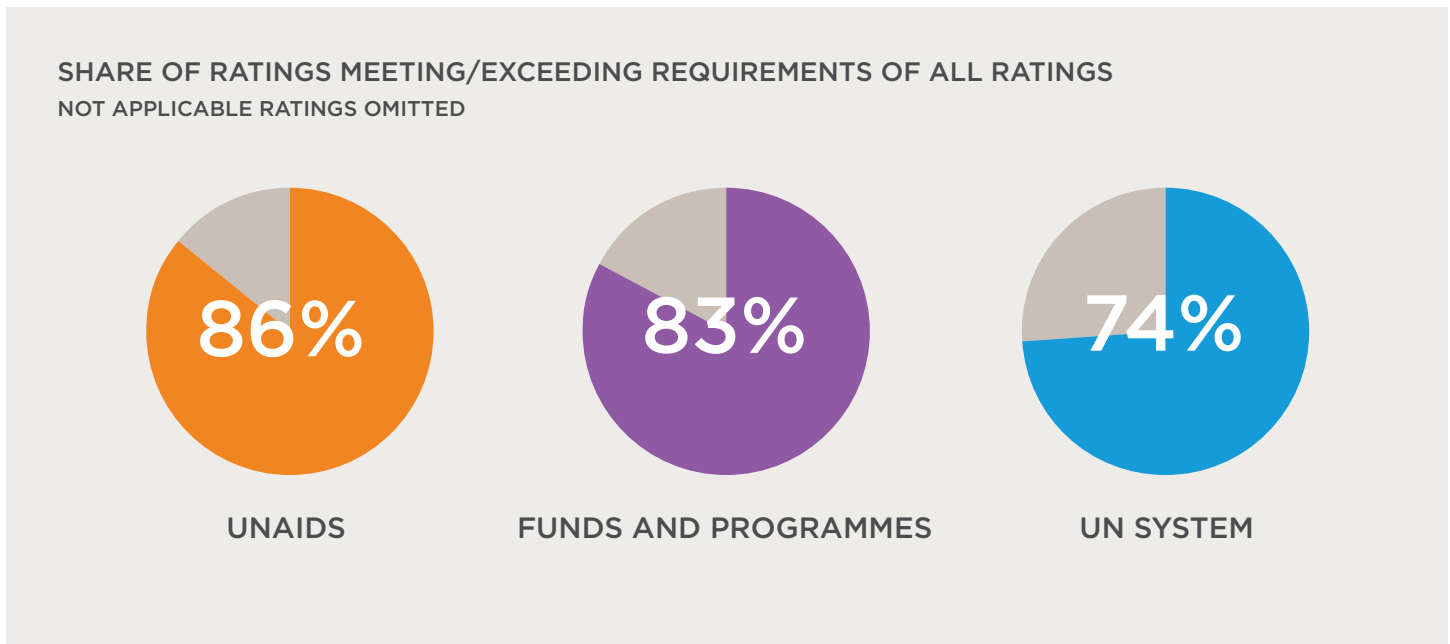
Most significant gains

- In 2022, UNAIDS exceeded the requirements for five indicators and met requirements for an additional nine.
- UNAIDS newly exceeded the requirements for the Knowledge and communication performance indicator.

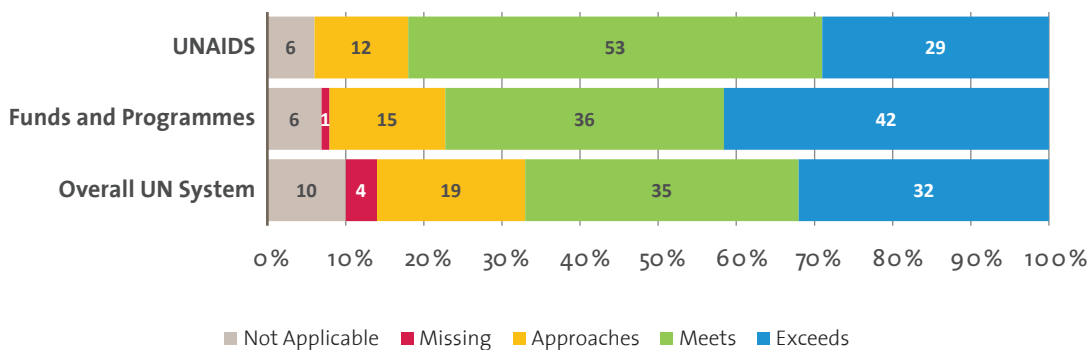
Areas for improvement

- The financial resource allocation indicator declined in rating from exceeding requirements to meeting requirements since 2021.
- UN Women encourages UNAIDS to focus renewed effort on the two remaining indicators rated as approaching requirements, Equal representation of women and Capacity assessment.

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR UNAIDS

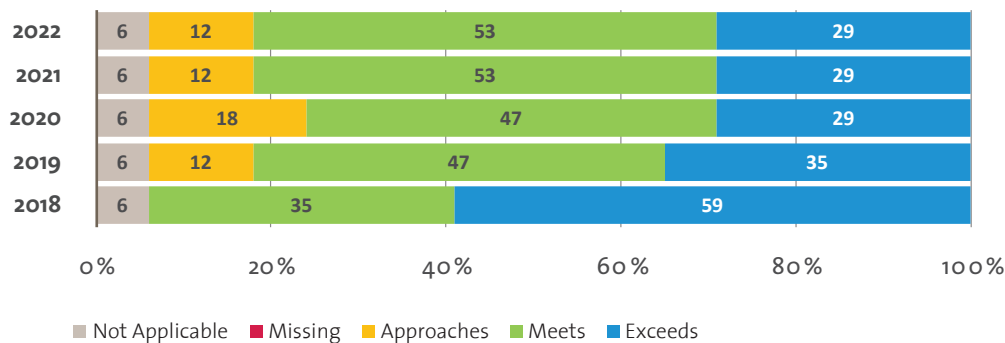


COMPARISON WITH THE FUNDS AND PROGRAMMES AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM



In 2022, UNAIDS met or exceeded the requirements for slightly more indicators than the average results of both the UN system and Funds and Programmes as whole. UNAIDS rated a smaller share of indicators as not applicable and did not miss requirements for any indicators.
