

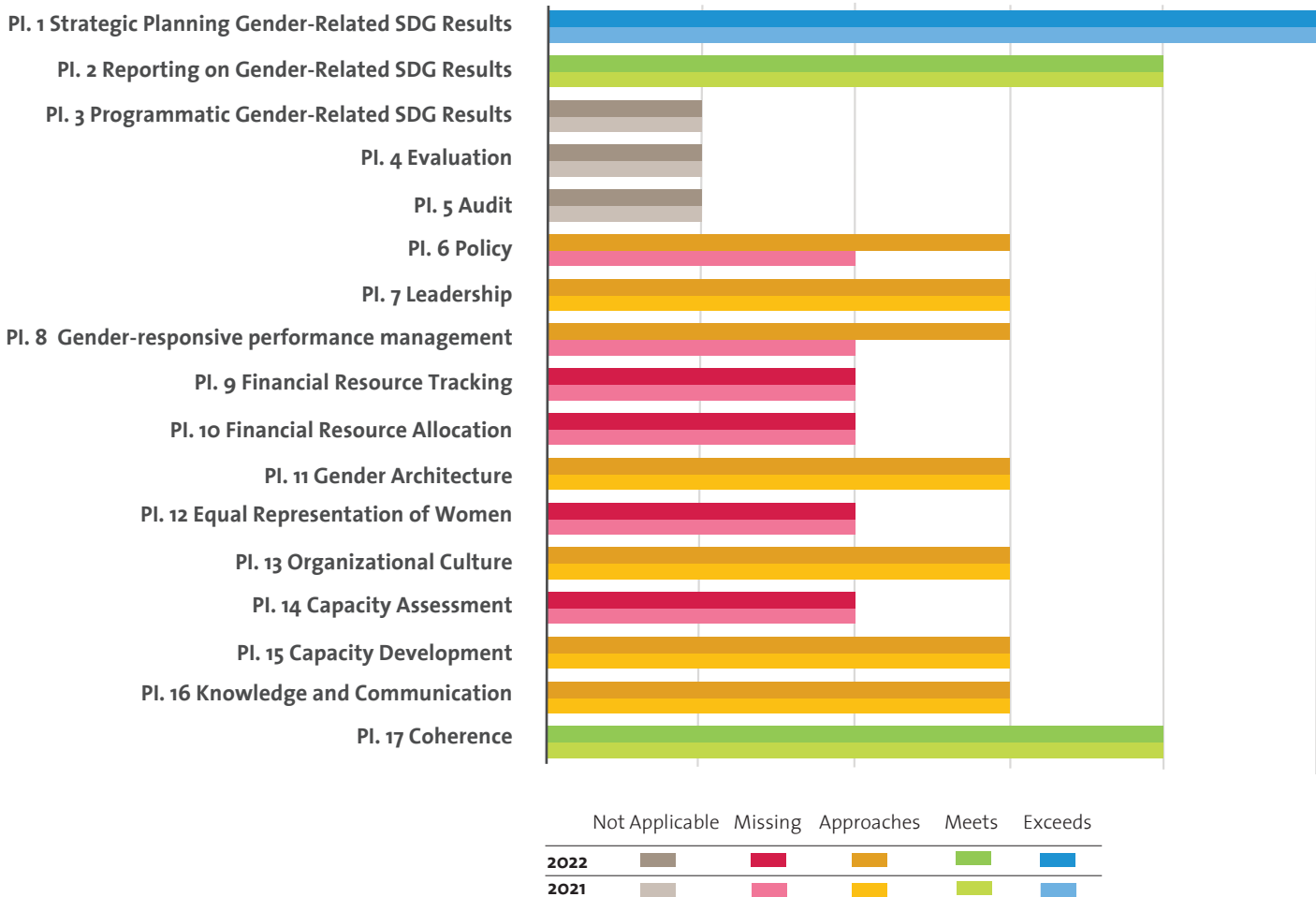

Most significant gains

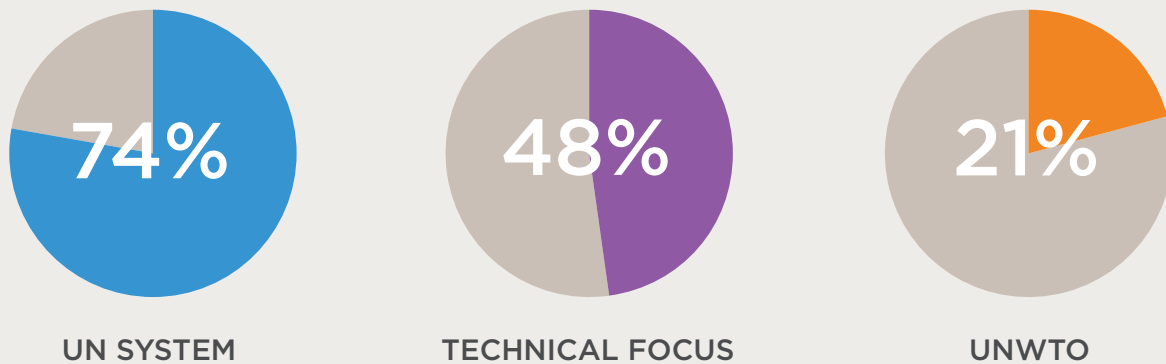
- In 2022, UNWTO exceeded the requirements for one indicator and met the requirements for two indicators.
- Significantly, UNWTO newly approached the requirements for two indicators: Policy and Gender-responsive performance management.

Areas for improvement

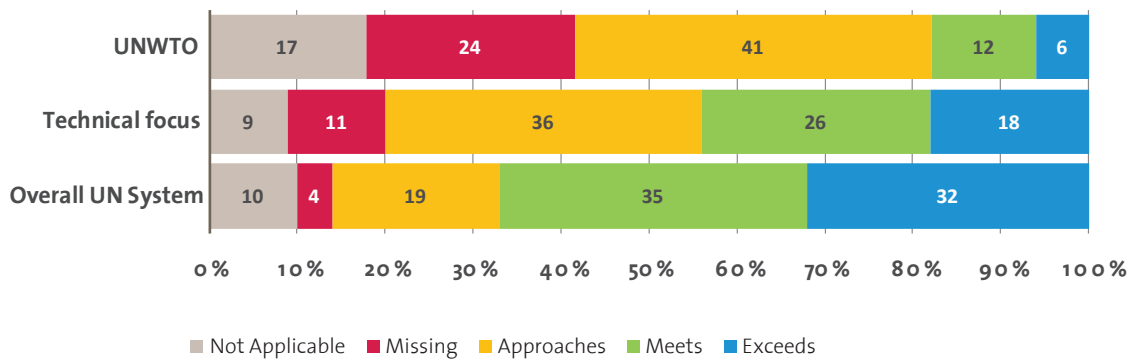
- UN Women encourages UNWTO to focus on some of the four indicators missing requirements and the seven indicators approaching requirements.
- In particular, UNWTO is encouraged to finalize the development of a gender equality policy. Gender policies have been identified as drivers of progress and foundational to overall UN-SWAP compliance.

NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED

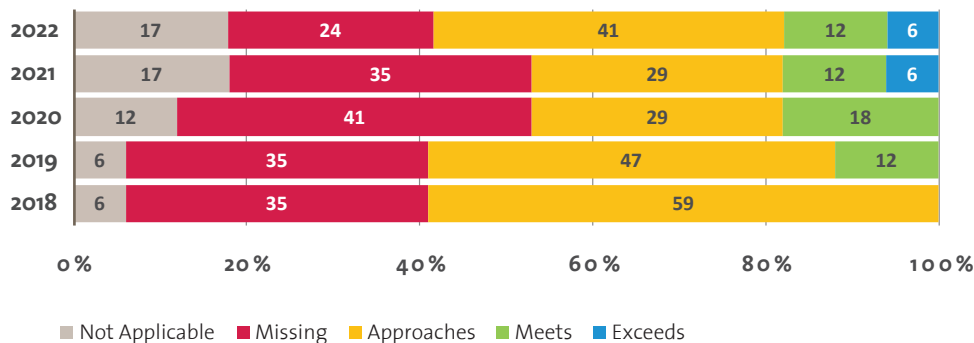


COMPARISON WITH TECHNICAL FOCUS ENTITIES AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM
