

Recommendation Summary

- 38 recommendations assigned to UN Women
 - 32 recommendations assigned to Executive Head
 - 6 recommendations assigned to Governing Body



Implementation Status at 30 April 2019

- 9 recommendations (24%) implemented
- 13 recommendations (34%) in progress
- 16 recommendations (42%) under consideration*

^{* 2} reports containing 18 recommendations were published 2019 (mid-April and mid-February) and UN Women is still assessing some of these recommendations



Update on prior years' reports and recommendations

Fully implemented applicable recommendations of 14 reports during 2018

Increased implementation rate to 84% for recommendations issued between 2012 and 2017

(compared to the average of 77% across participating organizations)
