Most significant gains


- In 2020, IOM exceeded the requirements for three indicators and met the requirements for five more indicators.

Areas for improvement


- UN Women encourages IOM to focus on the two missing and the seven indicators approaching requirements.

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR IOM




COMPARISON WITH FUNDS AND PROGRAMMES AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM
