
UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2020

- OCHA newly met the requirements for Coherence.


Areas for improvement






COMPARISON WITH SECRETARIAT ENTITIES AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM



- In 2020, OCHA met and exceeded significantly more indicators than the average for the UN Secretariat entities and the UN System as a whole.
- OCHA did not rate any indicators as not applicable.

OCHA, COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF RATINGS BY YEAR



- In 2020, OCHA met or exceeded the requirements for 76 per cent of the indicators, registering an increase by one indicator from 2019.
- OCHA exceeded the requirements for less indicators, but increased the share of indicators meeting requirements by 18 percentage points.
