
UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2020

Most significant gains

- In 2020, ODA exceeded the requirements for four indicators and met them for another nine indicators.
- Significantly, ODA newly exceeded Reporting on gender-related SDG results and newly met three indicators: Organizational culture, Capacity assessment and Coherence.


Areas for improvement

 UN Women encourages ODA to focus on the one area rated as missing and the remaining two areas rated as approaching requirements.


