
UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2020

Most significant gains

- In 2020, OSRSG-VAC exceeded requirements for five indicators and met them for another six indicators.
- Exceeding requirements on Policy and Leadership sets OSRSG-VAC on a strong path towards significant progress for gender equality and women's empowerment.


Areas for improvement

- UN Women encourages OSRSG-VAC to prioritize the three indicators marked as approaching requirements: Financial resource tracking, Capacity assessment and Coherence.
- UN Women also recommends reconsidering the applicability of the Financial resource allocation indicator.



- In 2020, OSRSG-VAC met and exceeded as many indicators as the average for the UN Secretariat and the UN System as a whole.
- While OSRSG-VAC did not miss any indicators, the entity did rate more indicators than average as not applicable.

OSRSG-VAC, COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF RATINGS BY YEAR



- In 2020, OSRSG-VAC rated five performance indicators as exceeding requirements, six as meeting requirements, three as approaching requirements and three as not applicable.
- Incorporating those indicators currently approaching requirements into OSRSG-VAC's work will greatly enhance performance in 2021.
