
UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2020

Most significant gains

- In 2020, UNDRR exceeded the requirements for three indicators and met them for another five indicators.
- UNDRR improved performance on Reporting on gender-related SDG results by exceeding the requirements in 2020.


Areas for improvement

 UN Women encourages UNDRR to focus efforts on Financial resource allocation which was rated as missing requirements and the six indicators rated as approaching requirements.

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR UNDRR




COMPARISON WITH THE SECRETARIAT AS A WHOLE AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM



In 2020, UNDRR met a similar share of indicators, but exceeded less indicators than the average for Secretariat entities and the UN system as a whole.

UNDRR, COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF RATINGS BY YEAR



- In 2020, UNDRR met or exceeded the requirements for 53 per cent of the indicators, registering a 23-percentage point decrease from 2019.
- The share of indicators that approached requirements has increased by 17 per centage points from 2019.
