

Most significant gains


- In 2020, UNITAR met the requirements for 10 indicators.

Areas for improvement


 UN Women encourages UNITAR to prioritize the two indicators rated as missing and the two indicators approaching requirements.



COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR UNITAR




COMPARISON WITH TRAINING INSTITUTES AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM
