Most significant gains

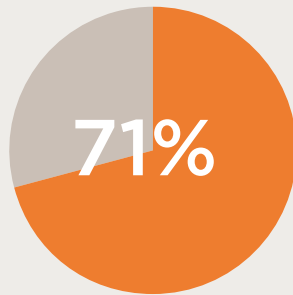
- In 2020, UNITAR met the requirements for 10 indicators.

Areas for improvement

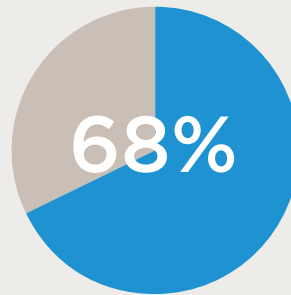
- UN Women encourages UNITAR to prioritize the two indicators rated as missing and the two indicators approaching requirements.

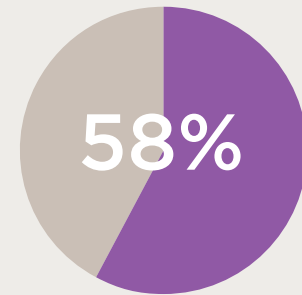
SHARE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS OF ALL RATINGS

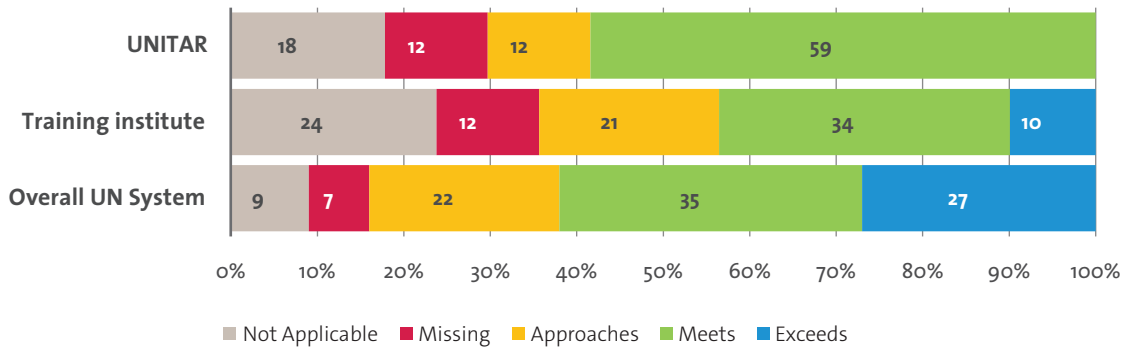

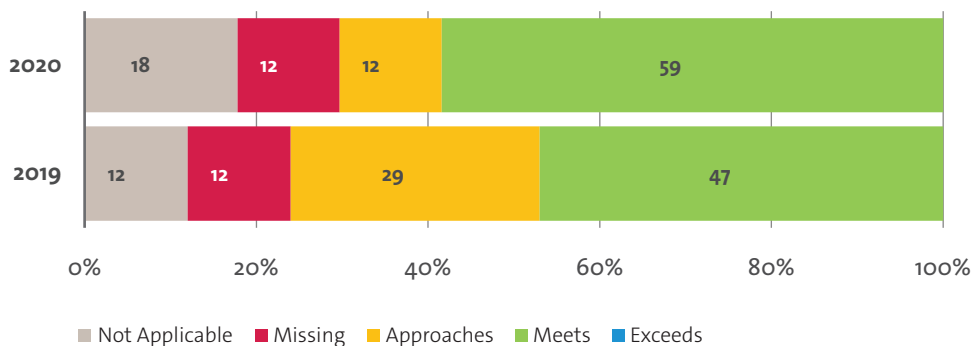

COMPARISON WITH TRAINING INSTITUTES AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM



- In 2020, UNITAR met significantly more indicators than the average for Training institutes, but less than the UN System as a whole.

UNITAR, COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF RATINGS BY YEAR



- In 2020, UNITAR met requirements for 10 performance indicators, an improved performance in two indicators in comparison with 2019 performance.
- Based on updated guidance for Training and research institutes regarding the results indicators, UNITAR rated an additional indicator as 'not applicable' in 2020.
