In 2020, OSRSG-CAAC met or exceeded the requirements for 8 performance indicators out of 15 applicable, a decline from 2019 performance.

### PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2020

#### Most significant gains

- In 2020, OSRSG-CAAC exceeded requirements for three indicators and met them for another five indicators.
- OSRSG-CAAC has improved performance this year on Leadership and Equal representation of women, a great achievement.

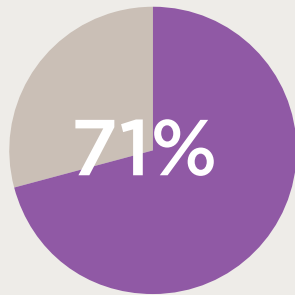
#### Areas for improvement

- UN Women encourages OSRSG-CAAC to prioritize the two indicators rated as missing: Financial resource allocation and Capacity assessment.
- UN Women also recommends focusing on the five indicators marked as approaching requirements, and in particular, Reporting on gender-related SDG results, Policy and Organizational culture, all of which have witnessed a decrease in performance.

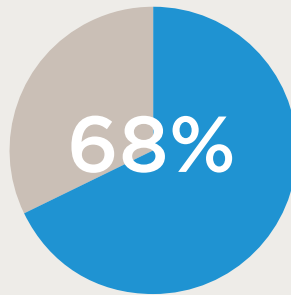

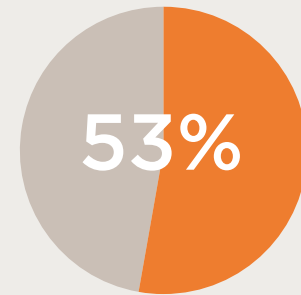
SHARE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS OF ALL RATINGS

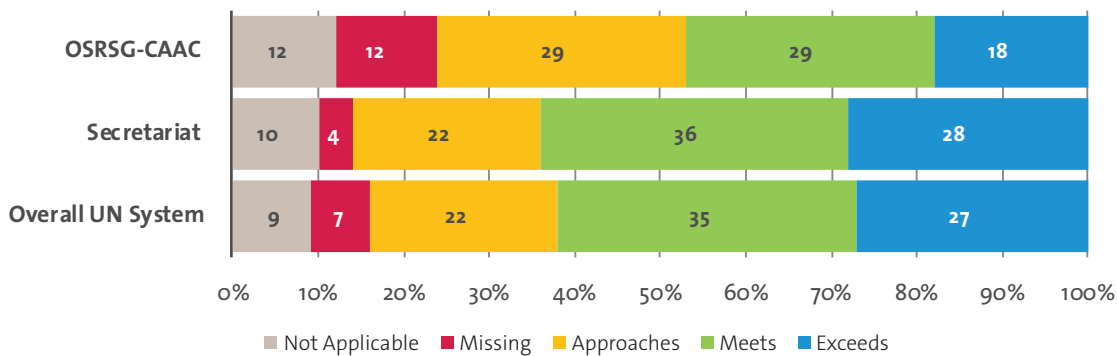

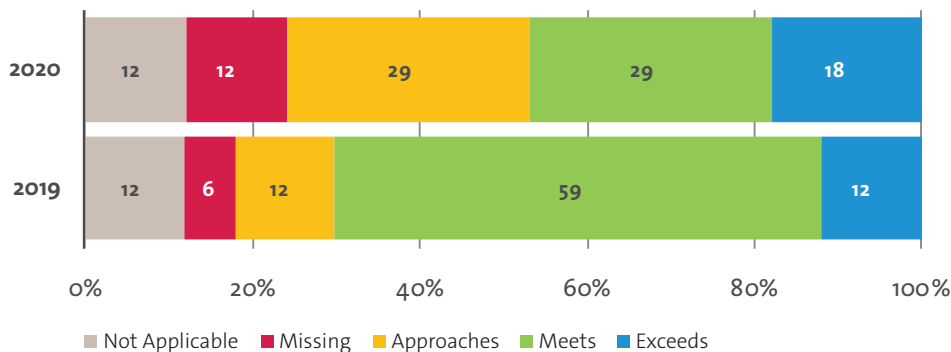

## COMPARISON WITH THE UN SECRETARIAT AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM



- In 2020, OSRSG-CAAC met or exceeded less indicators than the average for the UN Secretariat entities and the UN System as a whole.
- OSRSG-CAAC rated slightly more indicators as missing.

## OSRSG-CAAC, COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF RATINGS BY YEAR



- In 2020, OSRSG-CAAC exceeded requirements for one more indicator than in 2019.
- With respect to 2019, OSRSG-CAAC registered a 24-per cent decrease in indicators meeting or exceeding requirements in 2020.
