

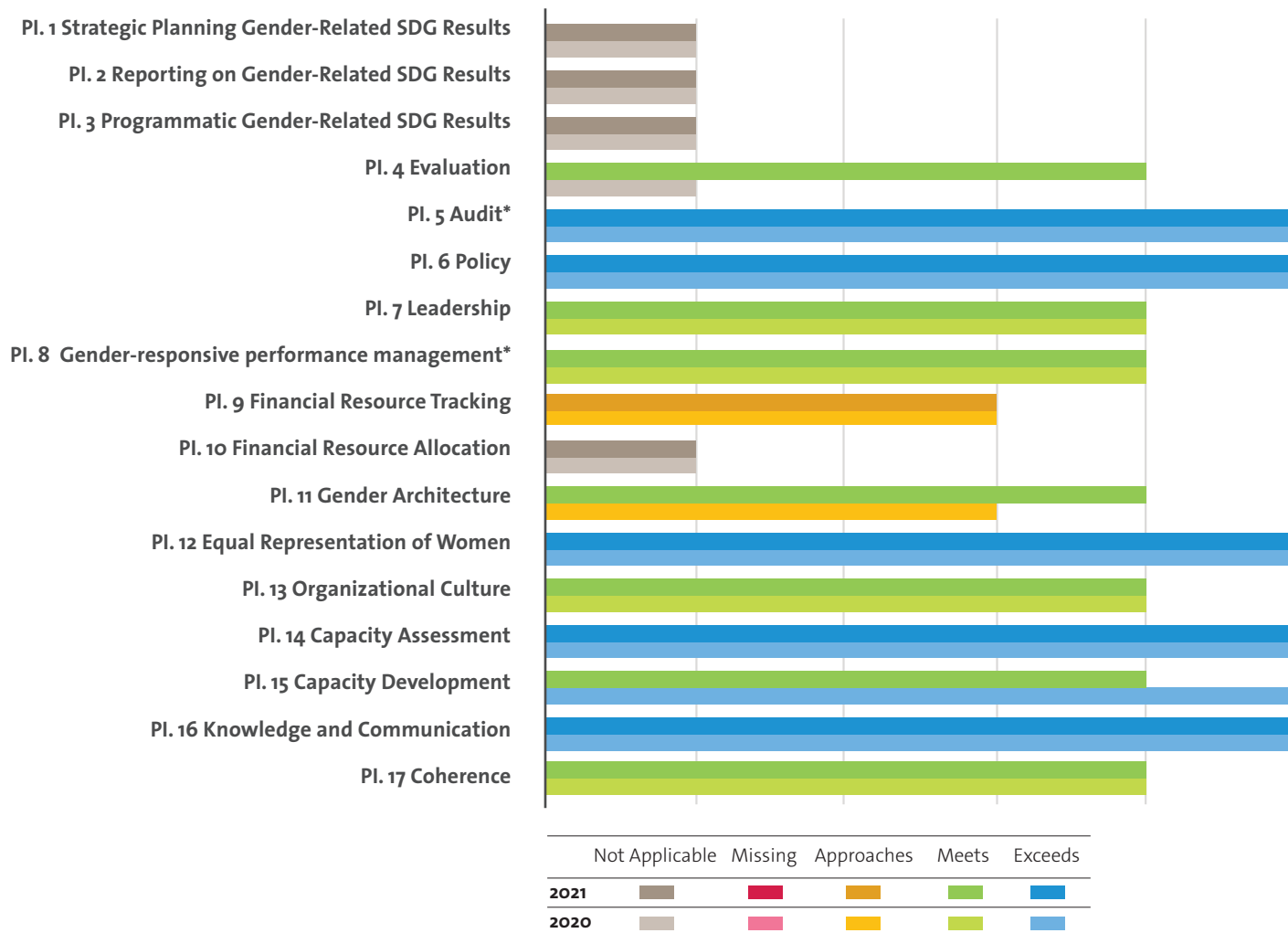

In 2021, DGACM met or exceeded the requirements for 12 performance indicators out of 13 applicable.

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2021

Most significant gains

- In 2021, DGACM exceeded the requirements for five indicators and met them for another seven indicators.
- DGACM newly met the requirements for Evaluation and Gender architecture.

Areas for improvement

- UN Women recommends prioritizing Financial resource tracking, the only remaining applicable indicator approaching requirements.
- DGACM is well positioned for full compliance in the current UN-SWAP implementation period.

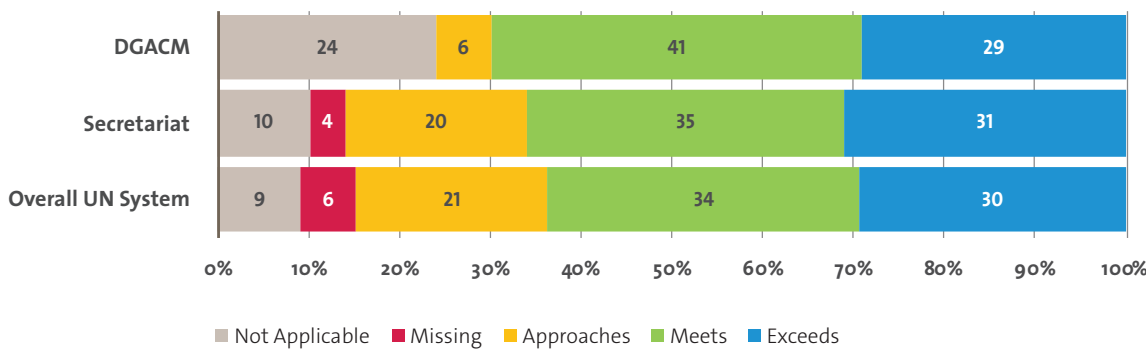

NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED



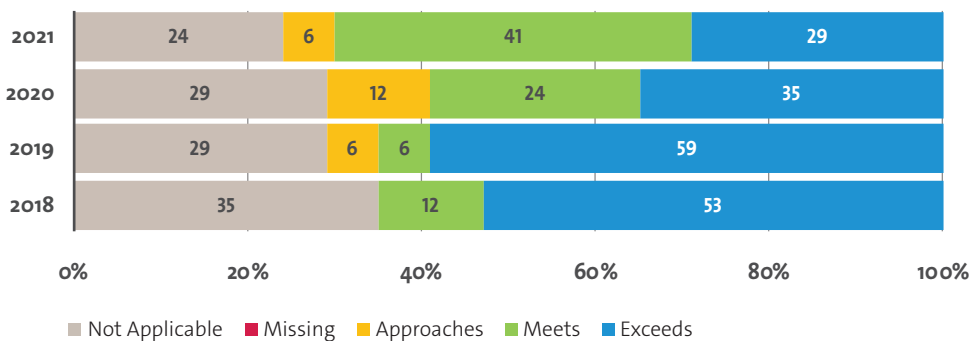
COMPARISON WITH THE SECRETARIAT AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM



In 2021, DGACM was among the top performing entities, meeting or exceeding the requirements for more indicators than the average of the UN Secretariat and the overall UN system.

As an entity with a mainly administrative focus, DGACM evaluated more indicators as not applicable than other UN Secretariat entities.

DGACM, COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF RATINGS BY YEAR



In 2021, DGACM reported exceeding or meeting an increased number of requirements, marking its highest compliance rate since the start of UN-SWAP 2.0 implementation in 2018.
