
UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2021

Most significant gains

- In 2021, DGC exceeded requirements for seven indicators and met requirements for another six indicators.
- Significantly, DGC newly met requirements for Equal Representation of Women.


Areas for improvement

- UN Women encourages DGC to focus efforts on Financial resource tracking and Gender Architecture, the two indicators rated as approaching requirements.
- With concerted effort on the remaining two indicators, DGC is well positioned to reach full compliance in the current UN-SWAP implementation period.



COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR DGC




COMPARISON WITH THE UN SECRETARIAT AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM
