

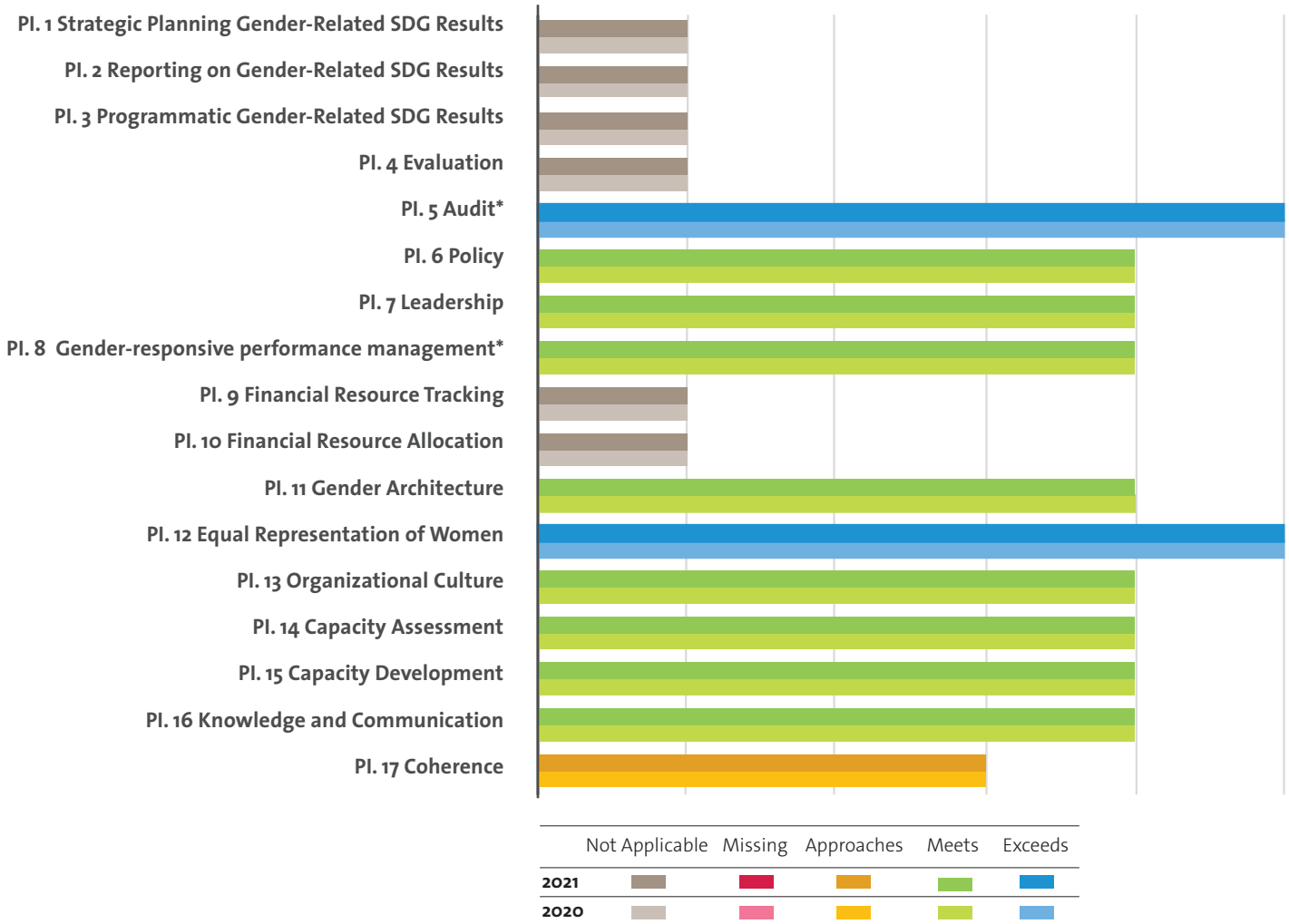

Most significant gains

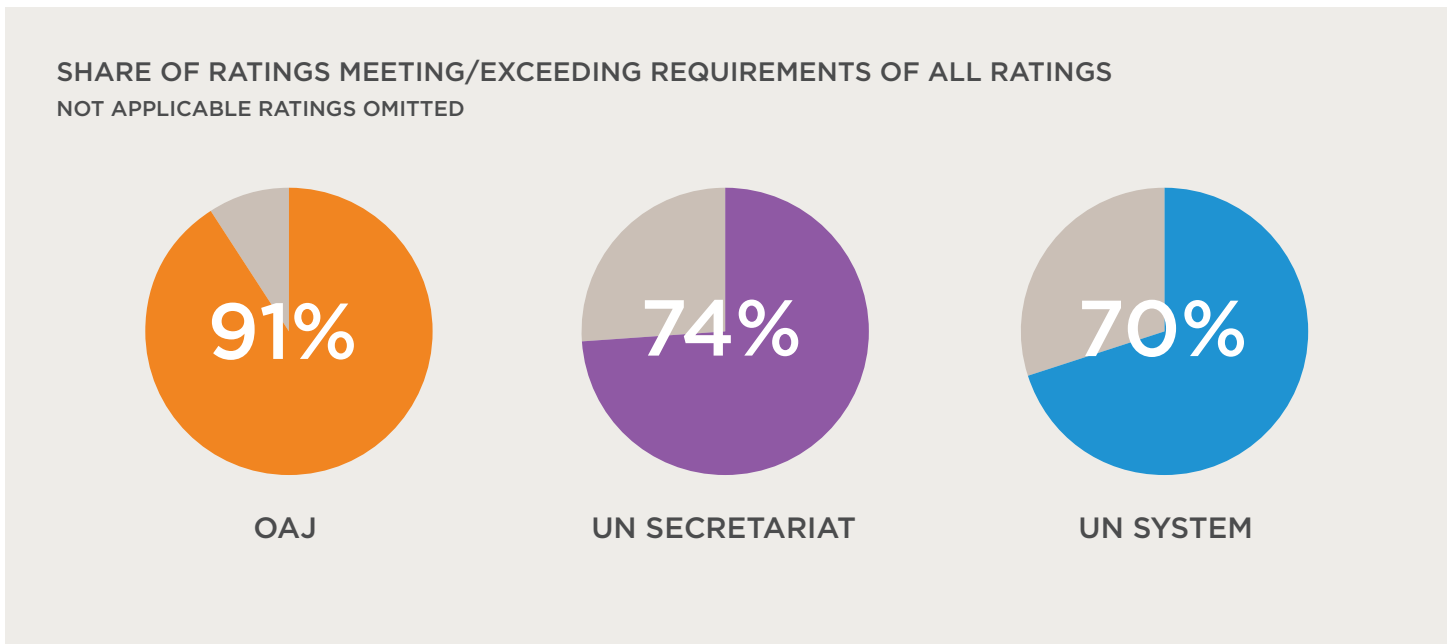
- In 2021, OAJ exceeded the requirements for two indicators and met them for another eight indicators.
- Significantly, OAJ continues to exceed requirements on the Equal representation of women.

Areas for improvement

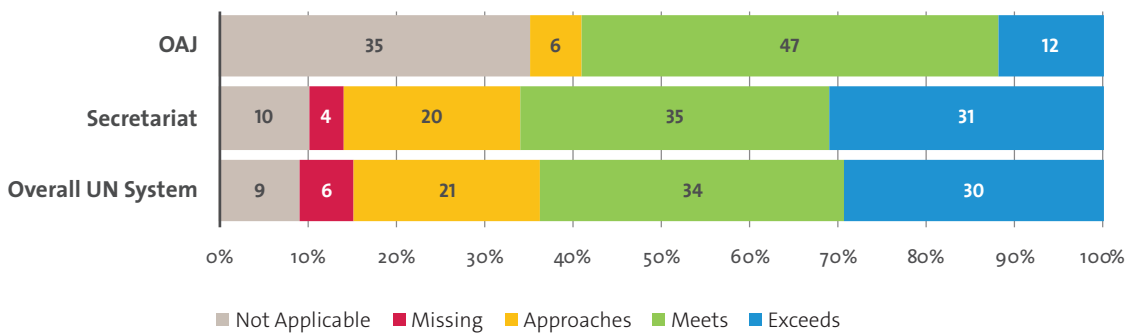
- UN Women encourages OAJ to engage in a peer review with another UN-SWAP reporting entity to meet the requirements for Coherence.
- OAJ is well positioned for full compliance within the current UN-SWAP implementation period.

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR OAJ



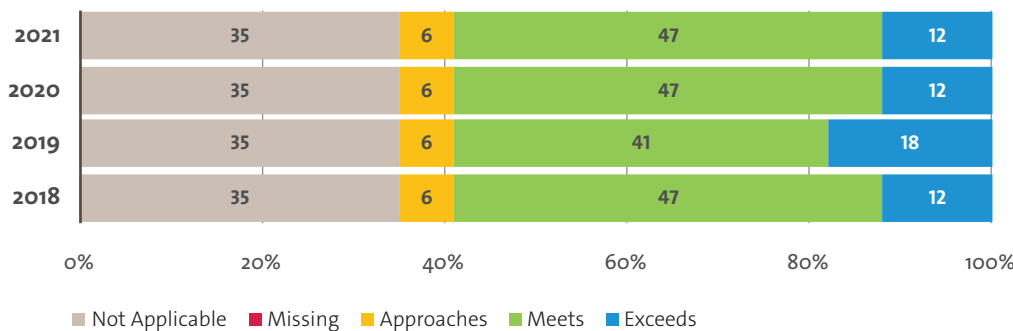
COMPARISON WITH THE UN SECRETARIAT AS A WHOLE AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM



In 2021, OAJ outperformed the combined results for the UN Secretariat as a whole and the UN System at large.

OAJ did not miss the requirements for any indicators, but assessed six indicators as not applicable to its work.
