

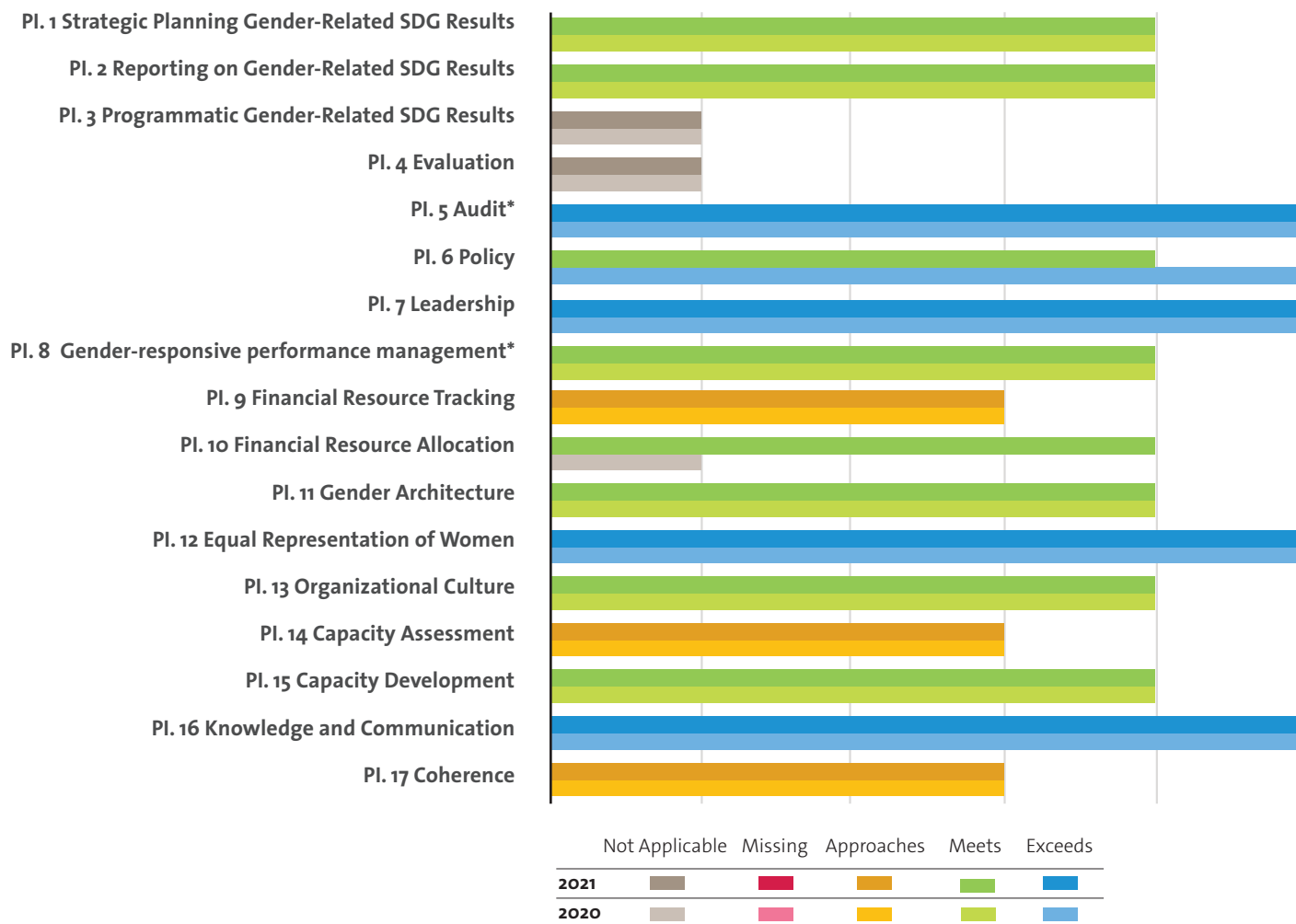

UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2021

The following two pages capture OSRSG-VAC's performance on UN-SWAP 2.0 indicators for 2021.

In 2021, OSRSG-VAC met or exceeded the requirements for 12 performance indicators out of 15 applicable, an improvement over 2020 results.

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2021

Most significant gains

- In 2021, OSRSG-VAC exceeded requirements for four indicators and met them for another eight indicators.
- OSRSG-VAC newly met the Financial resource allocation indicator, a historically challenging indicator for many UN-SWAP reporting entities.

Areas for improvement

- UN Women encourages OSRSG-VAC to prioritize the three indicators marked as approaching requirements: Financial resource tracking, Capacity assessment and Coherence.
- With concerted effort, OSRSG-VAC is well positioned for full compliance within the current UN-SWAP implementation period.

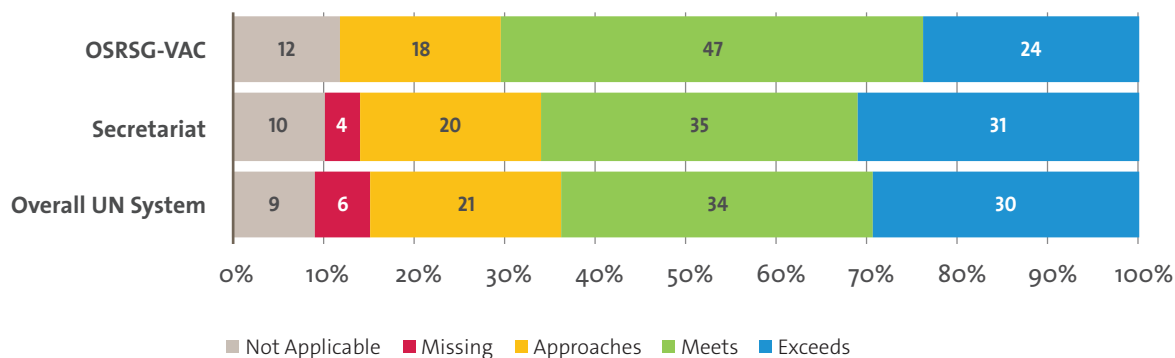

NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED

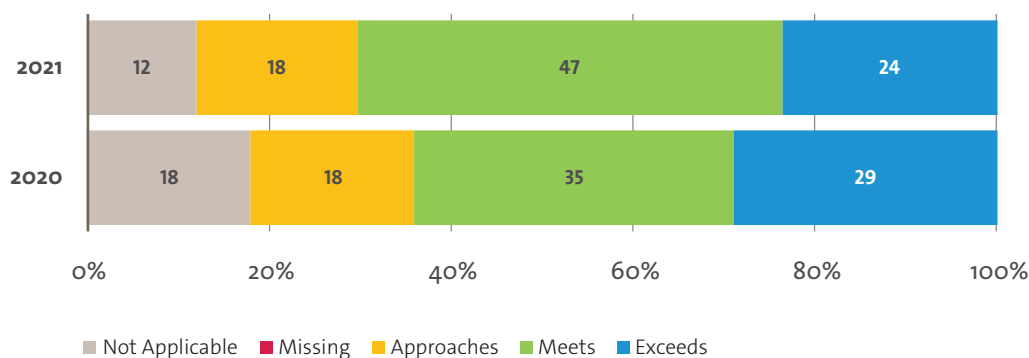


COMPARISON WITH THE SECRETARIAT AS A WHOLE AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM



In 2021, OSRSG-VAC performed slightly better than the combined results of the Secretariat and of the UN System as a whole.

In 2021, OSRSG-VAC improved upon 2020 results by increasing the number of applicable indicators from 14 to 15 and newly meeting its criteria.

OSRSG-VAC exceeded the requirements for one indicator less compared with 2020 results.
