

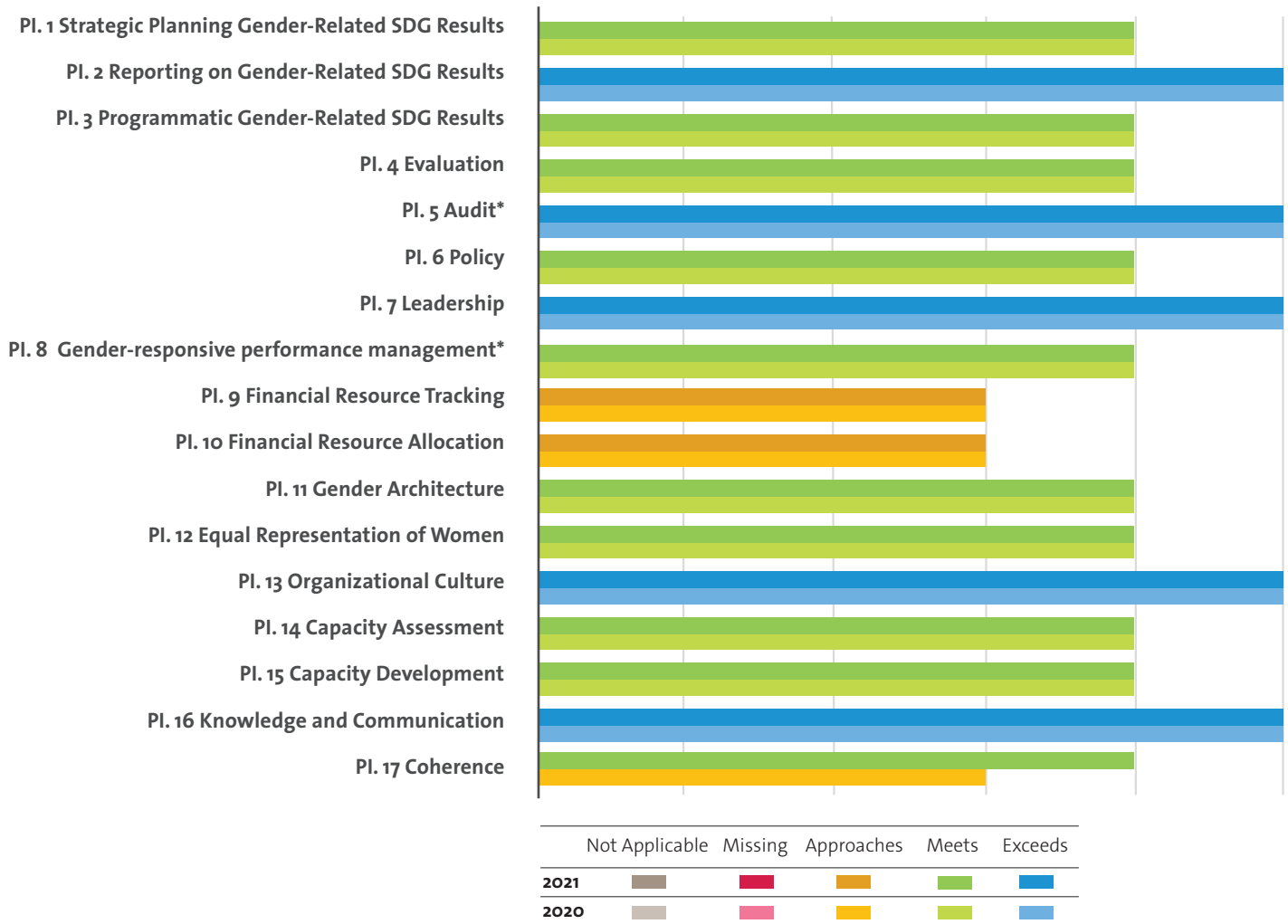
UNITED NATIONS CONVENTION TO COMBAT DESERTIFICATION (UNCCD)

- In 2021, UNCCD exceeded the requirements for five indicators and met the requirements for another ten indicators.

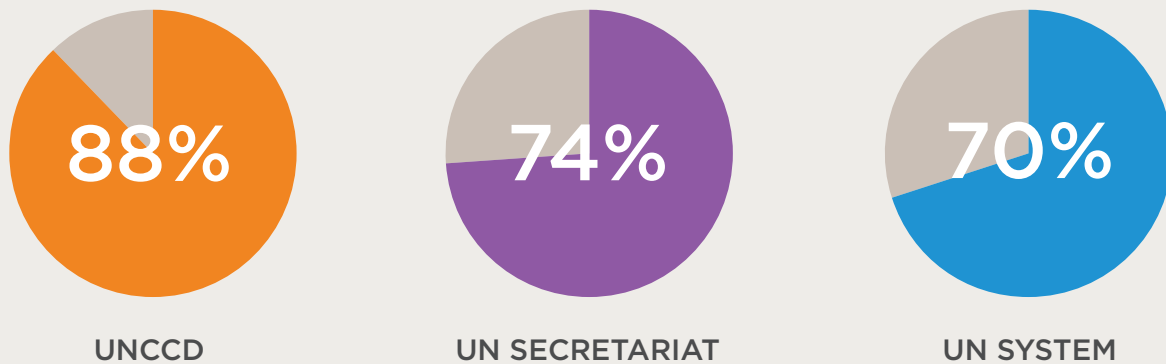
Areas for improvement

- UNCCD is well positioned to reach full compliance in the current UN-SWAP implementation period.

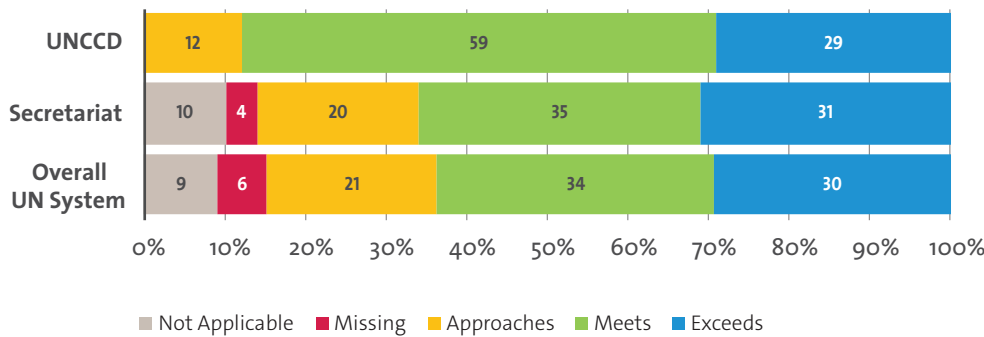

NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED



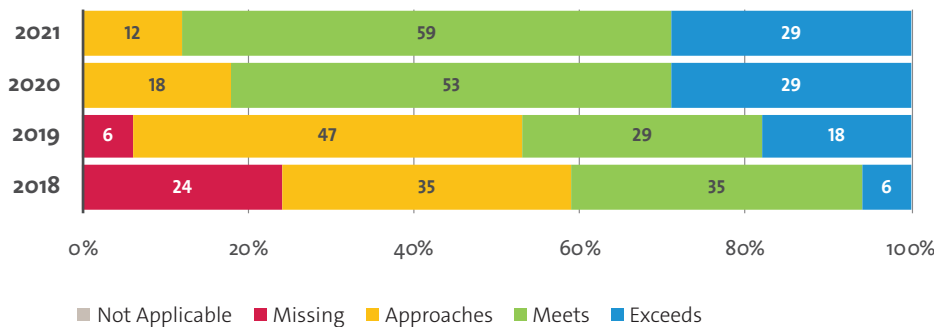
COMPARISON WITH THE FUNDS AND PROGRAMMES AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM
