

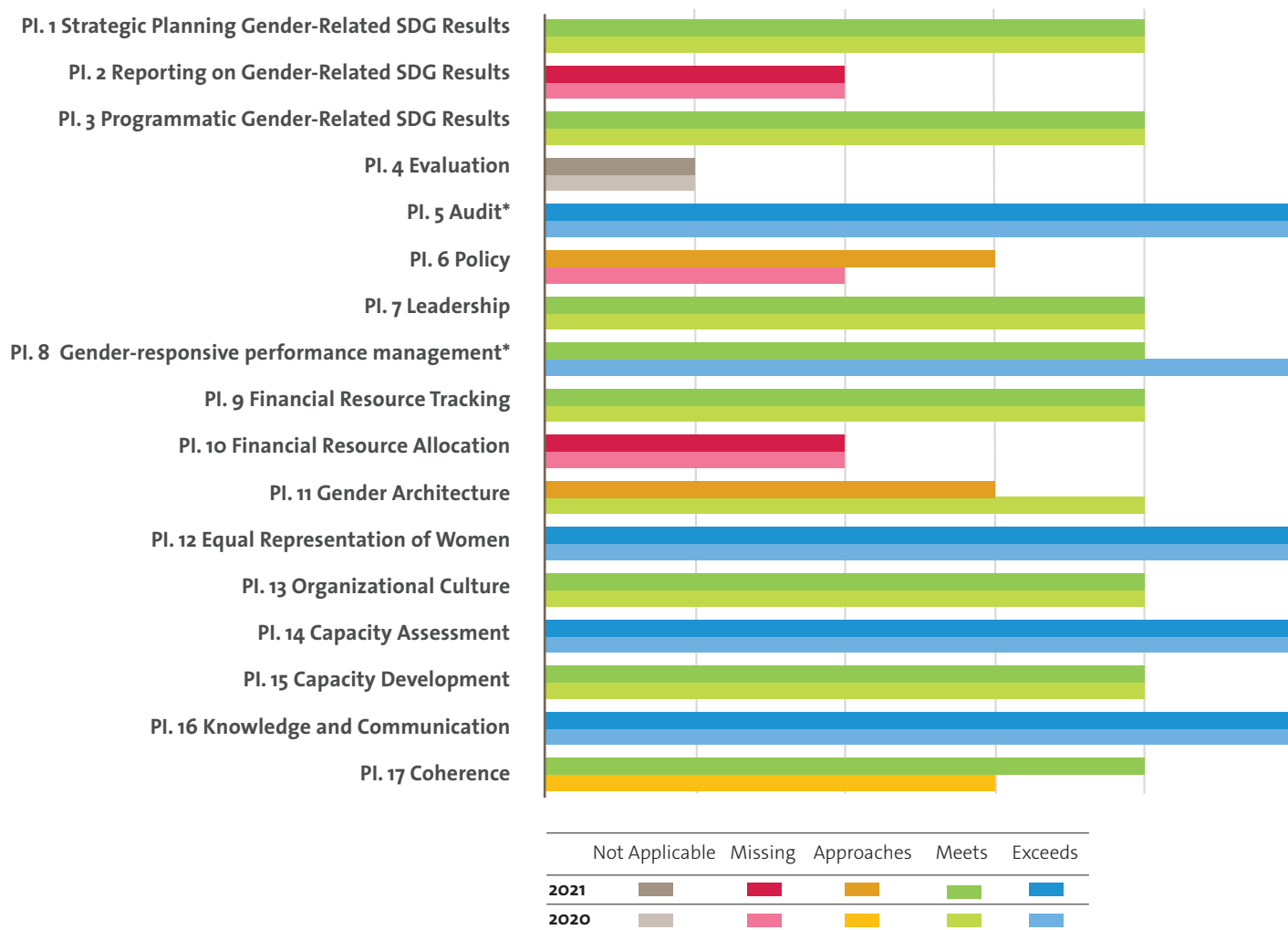

In 2021, the UN Global Compact met or exceeded the requirements for 12 performance indicators out of 16 applicable.

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2021

Most significant gains

- In 2021, the UN Global Compact exceeded the requirements for four indicators and met them for another eight indicators.
- Progress was made in two key areas: the development of a gender policy as well as Coherence, by undertaking a peer review.

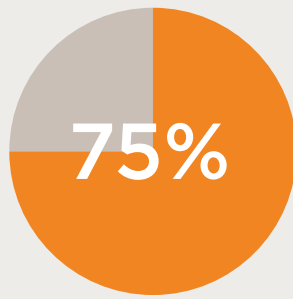
Areas for improvement

- UN Women encourages renewed focus on the two indicators areas rated as missing: Reporting on gender related SDG results and Financial resource allocation.
- With intensified efforts in the area of Gender architecture, the UN Global Compact will be well positioned for full compliance in the current UN-SWAP implementation period.

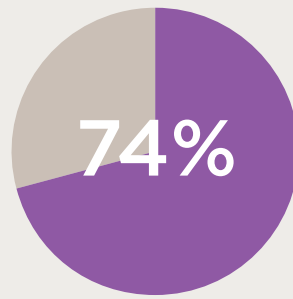

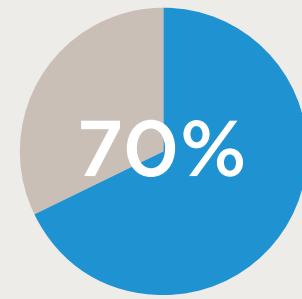
SHARE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS OF ALL RATINGS

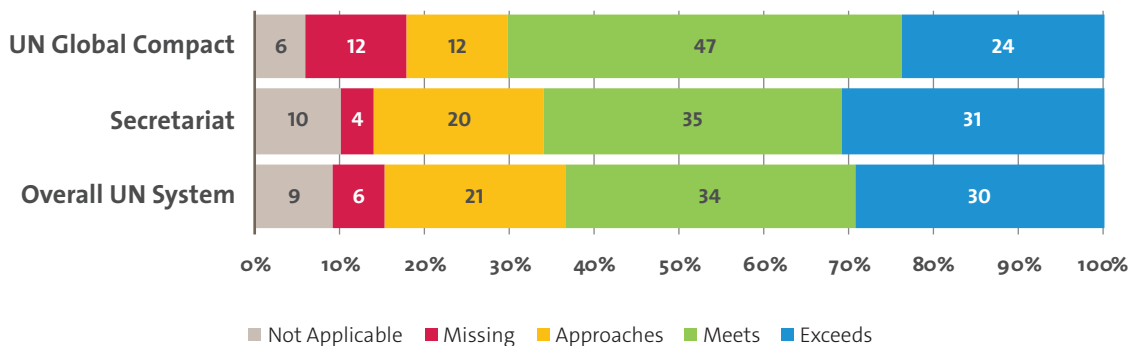

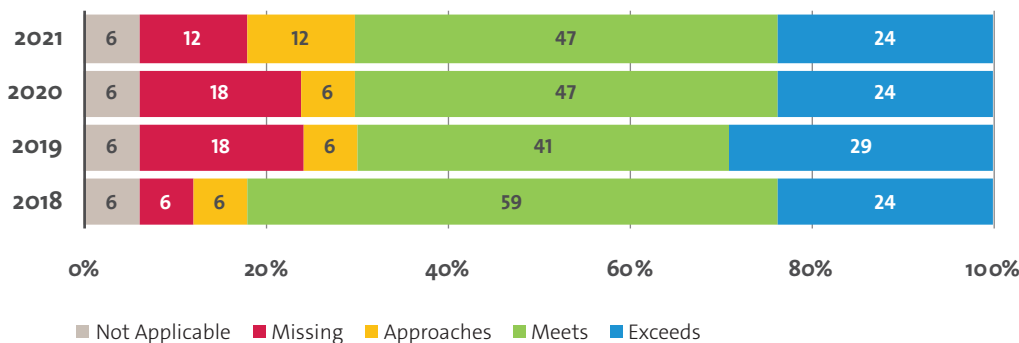
COMPARISON WITH THE SECRETARIAT AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM



In 2021, the UN Global Compact met and exceeded more indicators than both the average for the Secretariat and the UN System as a whole.

Despite an overall strong performance, UN Global Compact missed requirements for significantly more indicators comparatively.
