

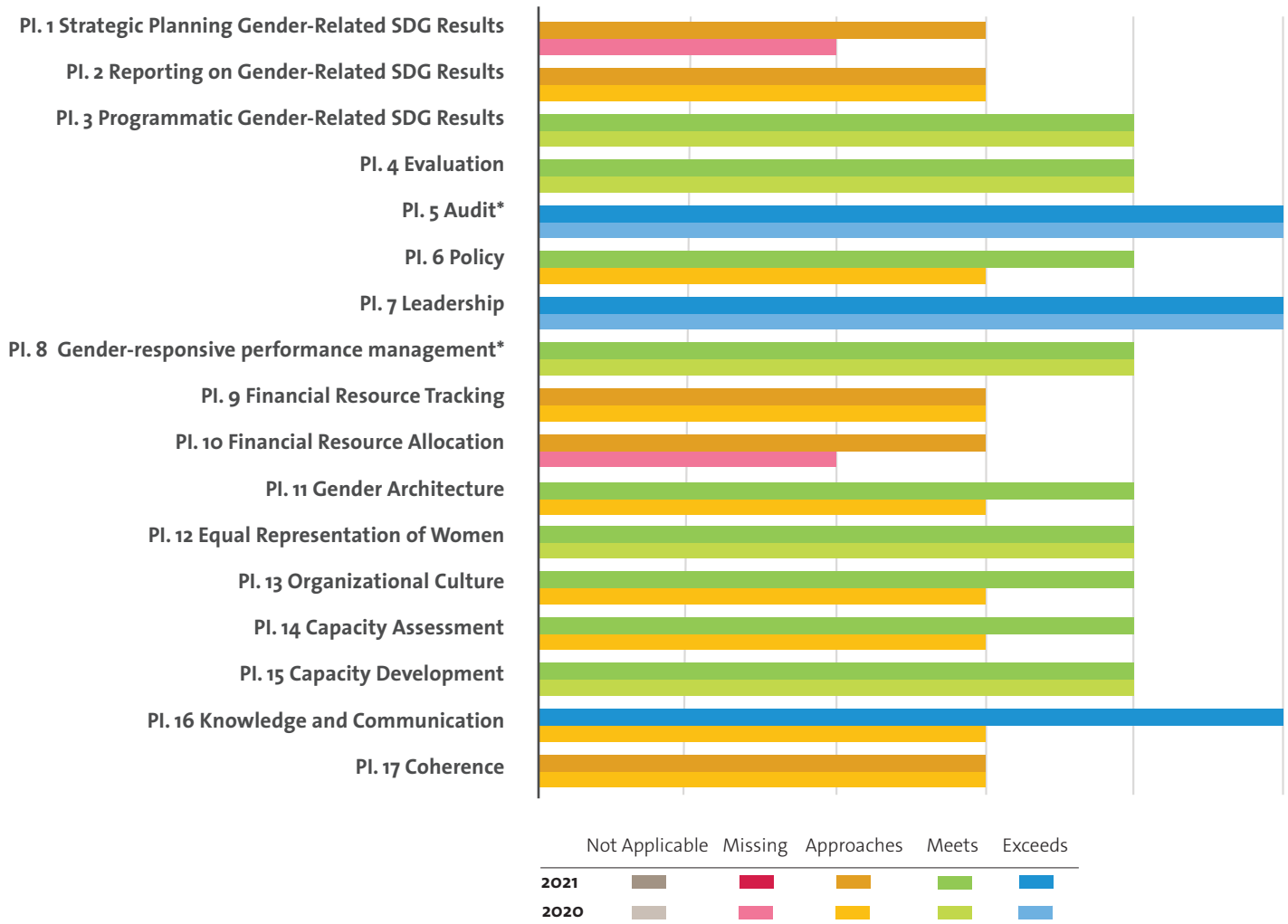

UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2021

The following two pages capture UNOCT's performance on UN-SWAP 2.0 indicators for 2021.

In 2021, UNOCT met or exceeded the requirements for 12 performance indicators out of 17, a significant improvement in comparison to 2020 results.

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2021

Most significant gains

- In 2021, UNOCT exceeded the requirements for three indicators and met the requirements for another nine indicators.
- Significantly, UNOCT newly exceeded the requirements for the Knowledge and communication indicator and improved performance on six others.

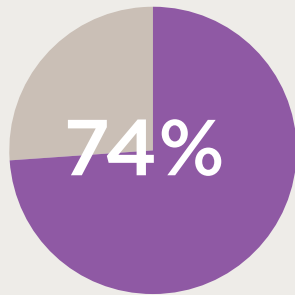
Areas for improvement

- UN Women encourages UNOCT to focus efforts on the remaining five indicators rated as approaching requirements. Doing so will bring UNOCT closer to achieving full compliance during the current UN-SWAP implementation period.

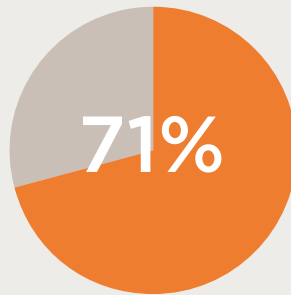

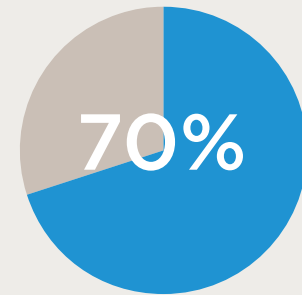
SHARE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS OF ALL RATINGS

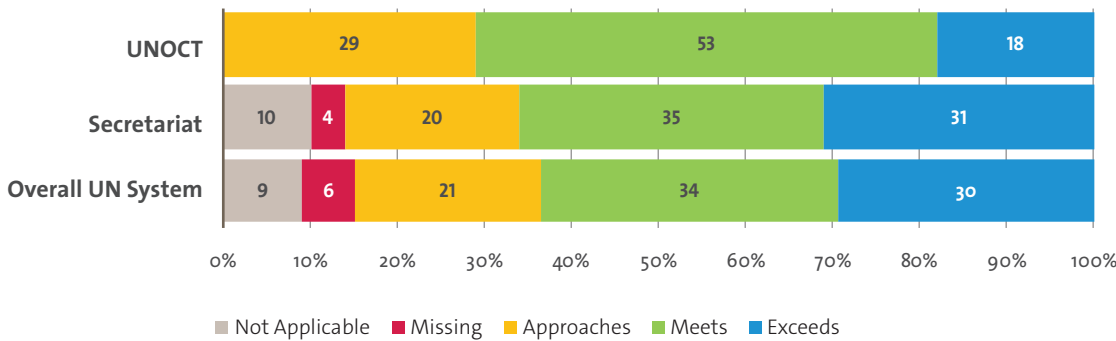

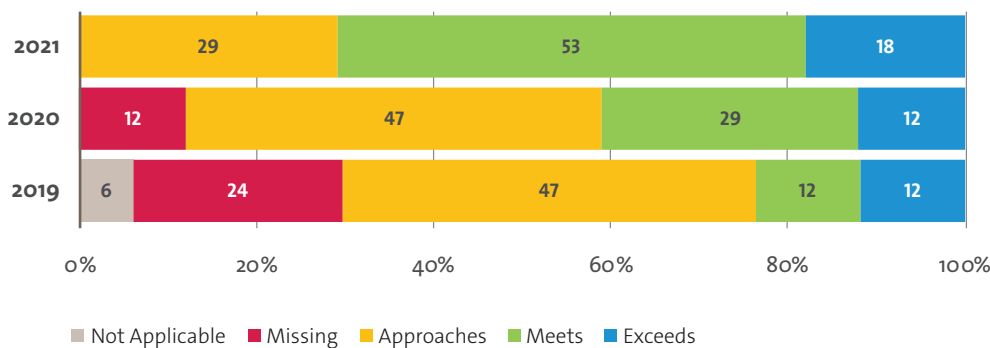
UN SYSTEM

In 2021, UNOCT matched the average performance of both the UN System and of the UN Secretariat as a whole.

In 2021, UNOCT achieved its highest UN-SWAP 2.0 performance to date.

UNOCT met or exceeded significantly more indicators this year than in their first two years of reporting, no longer missed requirements of any indicator and deemed all seventeen indicators as applicable to their work.
