

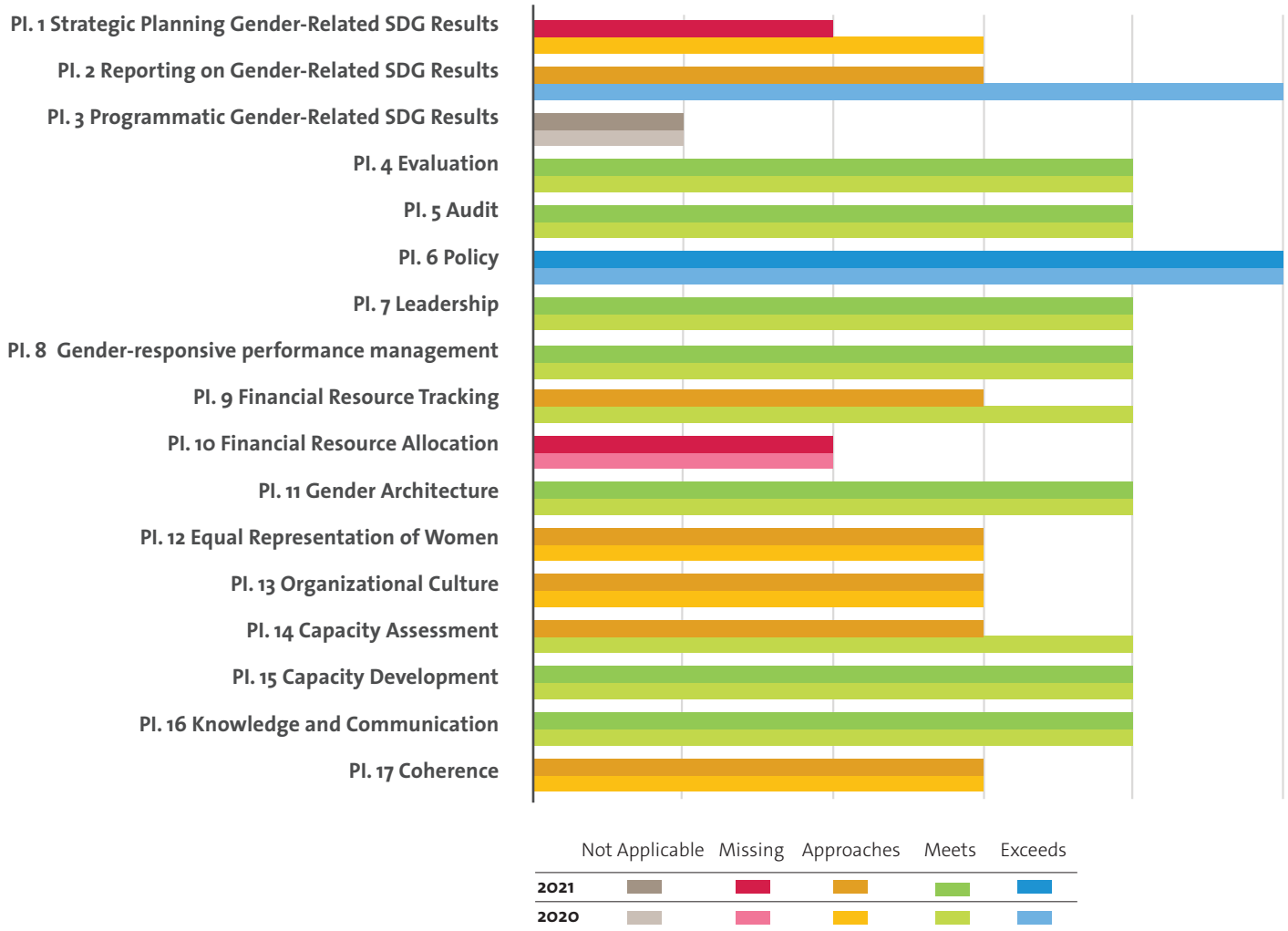

Most significant gains

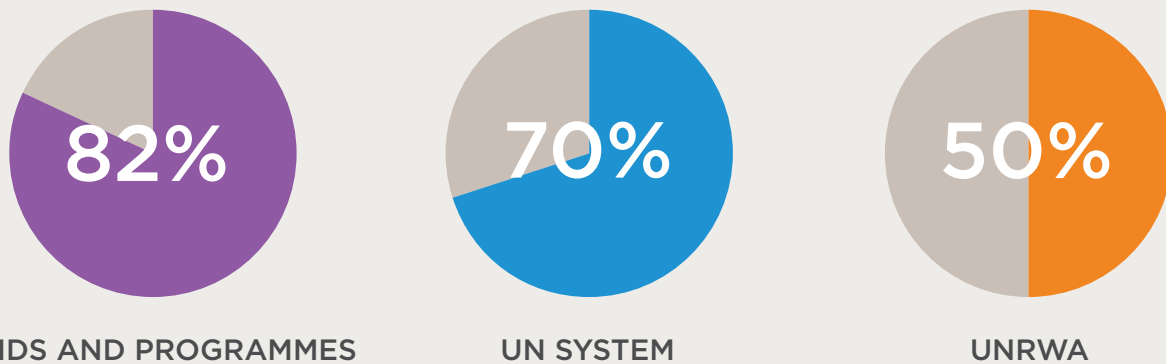
- In 2021, UNRWA exceeded the requirements for one indicator and met the requirements for another seven indicators.

Areas for improvement

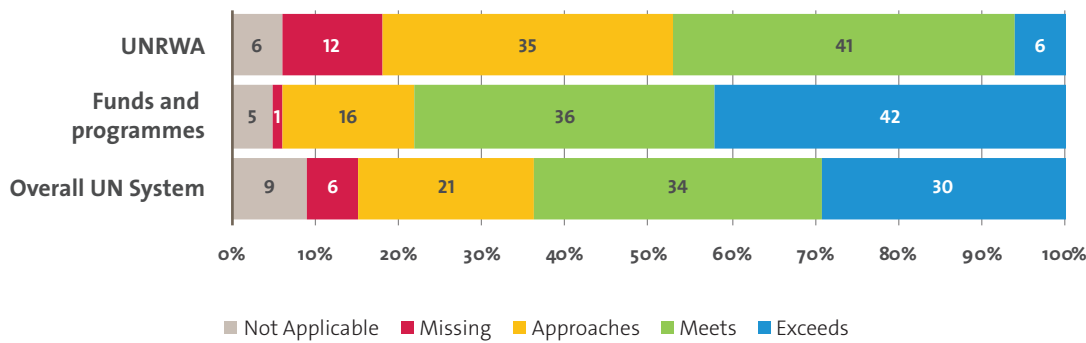
- UN Women encourages UNRWA to focus efforts on the two indicators rated as missing requirements and the six indicators rated as approaching requirements.

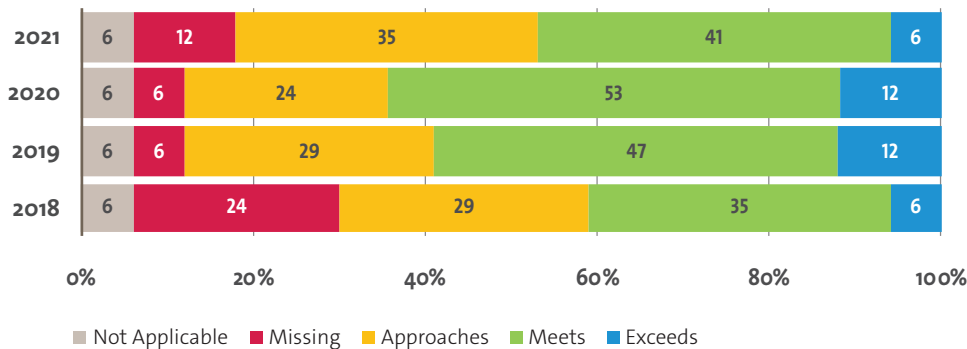


COMPARISON WITH THE FUNDS AND PROGRAMMES AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM
