

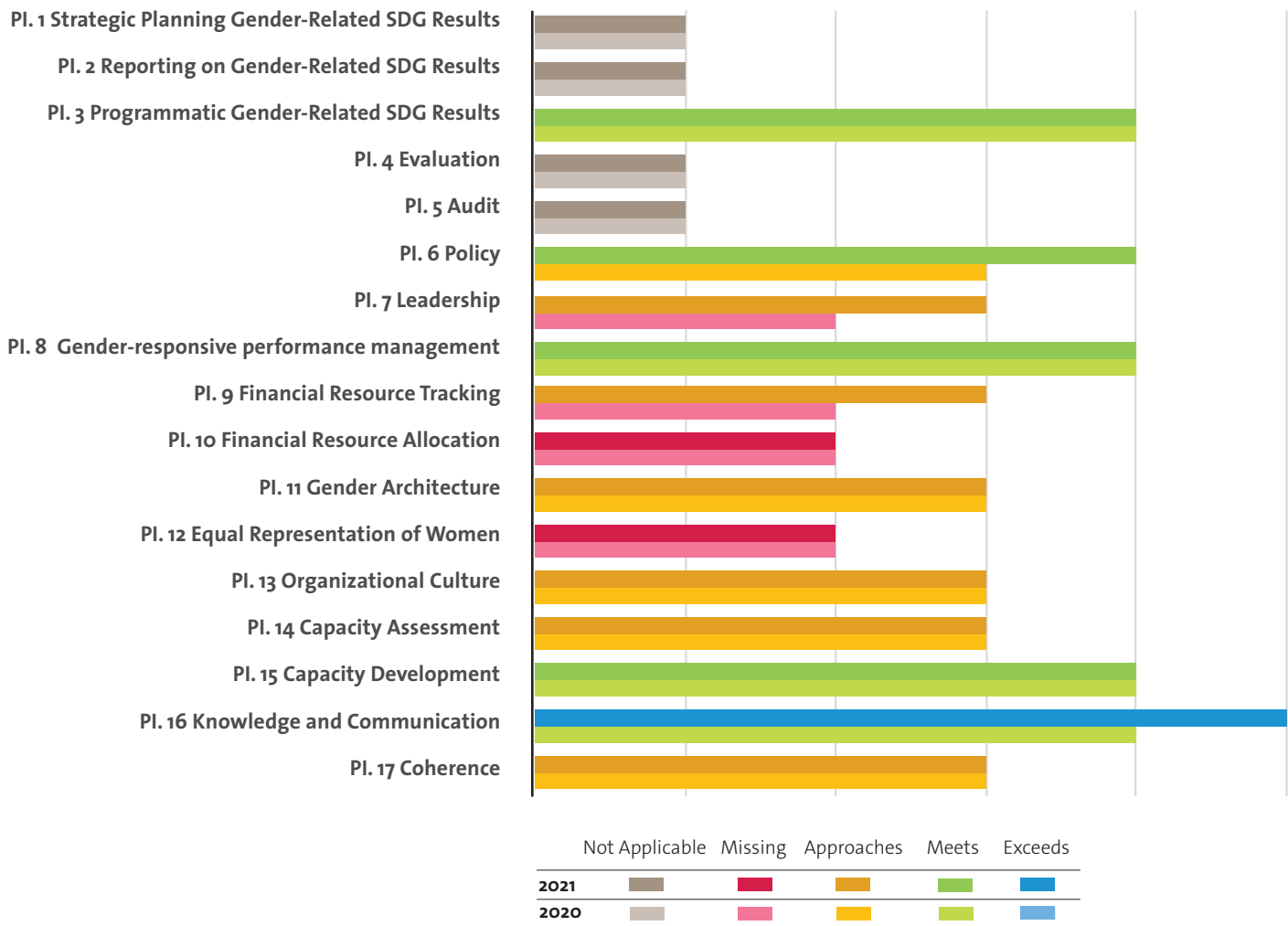

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2021

Most significant gains

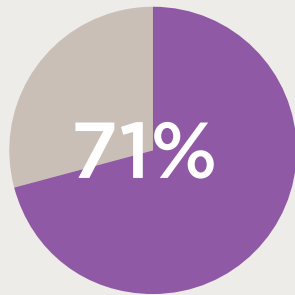
- In 2021, UNSSC exceeded requirements for one performance indicator and met them for another four indicators.
- UNSSC newly exceeded requirements on the Knowledge and communication indicator and improved performance on three additional indicators integral to overall UN-SWAP 2.0 progress: Policy, Leadership and Financial resource tracking.

Areas for improvement

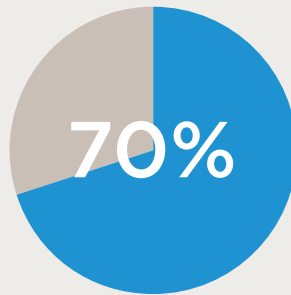
- UN Women encourages UNSSC to prioritize the two indicators rated as missing and the six indicators rated as approaching requirements to push performance during the current UN-SWAP implementation period.

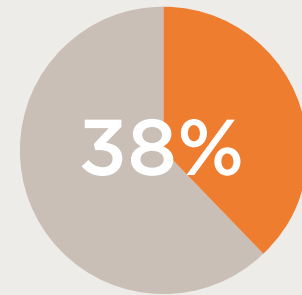
SHARE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS OF ALL RATINGS

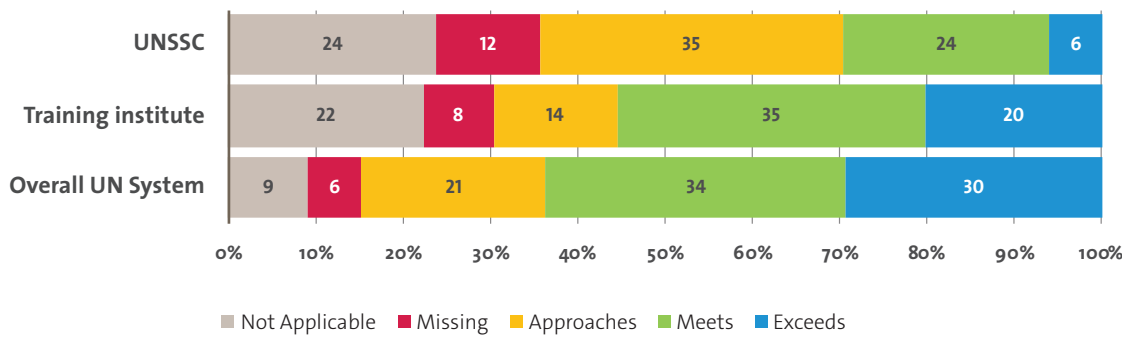

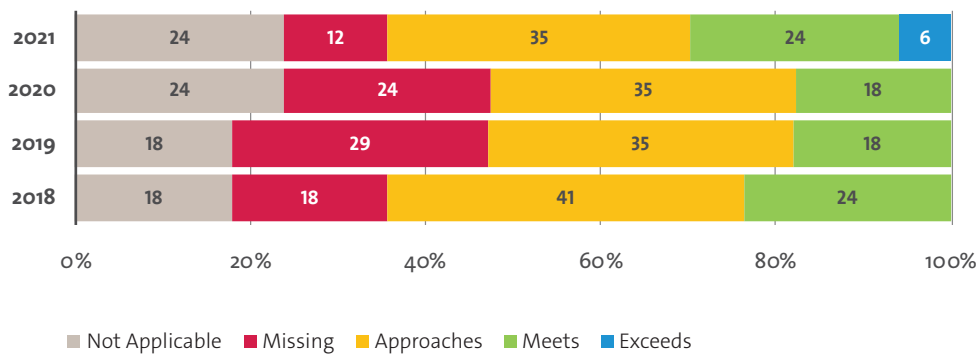
