GOVERNMENT RESPONSES TO COVID-19: REGIONAL APPENDIX

LATIN AMERICA AND THE CARIBBEAN

Globally, Latin America and the Caribbean is one of the two regions with the highest aggregate number of gender-sensitive measures (414) and measure density, averaging 9 measures per country/territory. It also ranks second in terms of women's representation (28%) and leadership (23%) in COVID-19 task forces, following Europe and Northern America, Australia and New Zealand. The region records the largest number of measures supporting women's economic security across all

mechanisms (39)

regions and accounts for half of all active labour market policies aimed at helping women regain employment or supporting their entrepreneurship. In the Global South, Latin America and the Caribbean leads the response on addressing violence against women and girls (214 measures in 32 countries/ territories), as well as on unpaid care (33 measures in 17 countries/territories) – a reflection of growing feminist activism and increasing government commitments to care policies.

FIGURE A-1 Number and percentage of gender-sensitive measures out of all social protection and labour market measures in Latin America and the Caribbean




FIGURE A-2 Average share of women members in COVID-19 task forces in Latin America and the Caribbean


