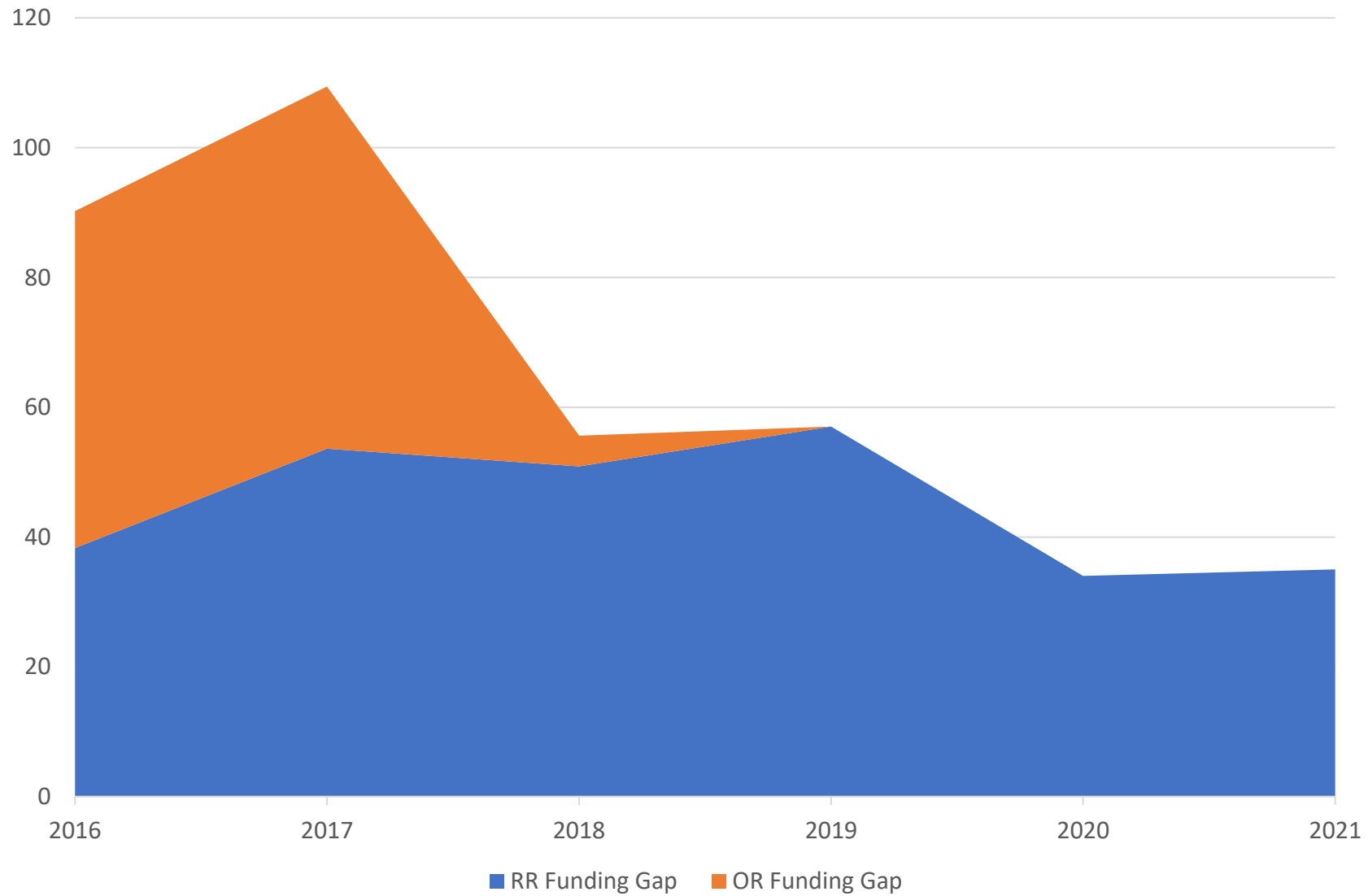
\*2018 revenue reflects figures complying to the change in UNBOA Revenue Recognition Policy for Financial Statements.



Despite overall growth in RR, the actual share of RR has steadily declined from **55%** in 2011 to **30.2%** in 2021 (below the 41% target in the Integrated Budget)

- Influence others: leverage **UN system coordination** and strengthen partnerships with **IFIs** for financing the mandate.
- Maintain and deepen **public sector support** and expand UN-Women's partnership base.
- Grow partnerships with the **private sector**
- Direct funding of **multi-year strategic notes** at country and regional levels.
