


NARROWING THE GENDER GAP IN HUMANITARIAN RESPONSE





- As co-chair of the IASC Gender Reference Group, we lead accountability for gender commitments across **31 contexts**.
- We contribute to humanitarian and refugee coordination mechanisms in >40 country and regional contexts
- We extend gender expertise to **87%** of humanitarian cluster systems in countries where we are present
 - Direct support to women's rights and women led organizations, enabling delivery of services responding to needs of women and girls: >803,000 crisisaffected women and girls reached in 2022
