PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2022


Most significant gains

- DCO improved performance across two performance indicators, Strategic Planning Gender-related results and Capacity Assessment.


Areas for improvement

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR DCO




COMPARISON WITH THE SECRETARIAT AS A WHOLE AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM
