

- Significantly, DGC newly exceeded requirements for three indicators: Leadership, Capacity assessment and Capacity development.


Areas for improvement

 UN Women encourages DGC to focus efforts on Financial resource tracking and Gender Architecture, the two indicators rated as approaching requirements.



COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR DGC




COMPARISON WITH THE UN SECRETARIAT AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM
