

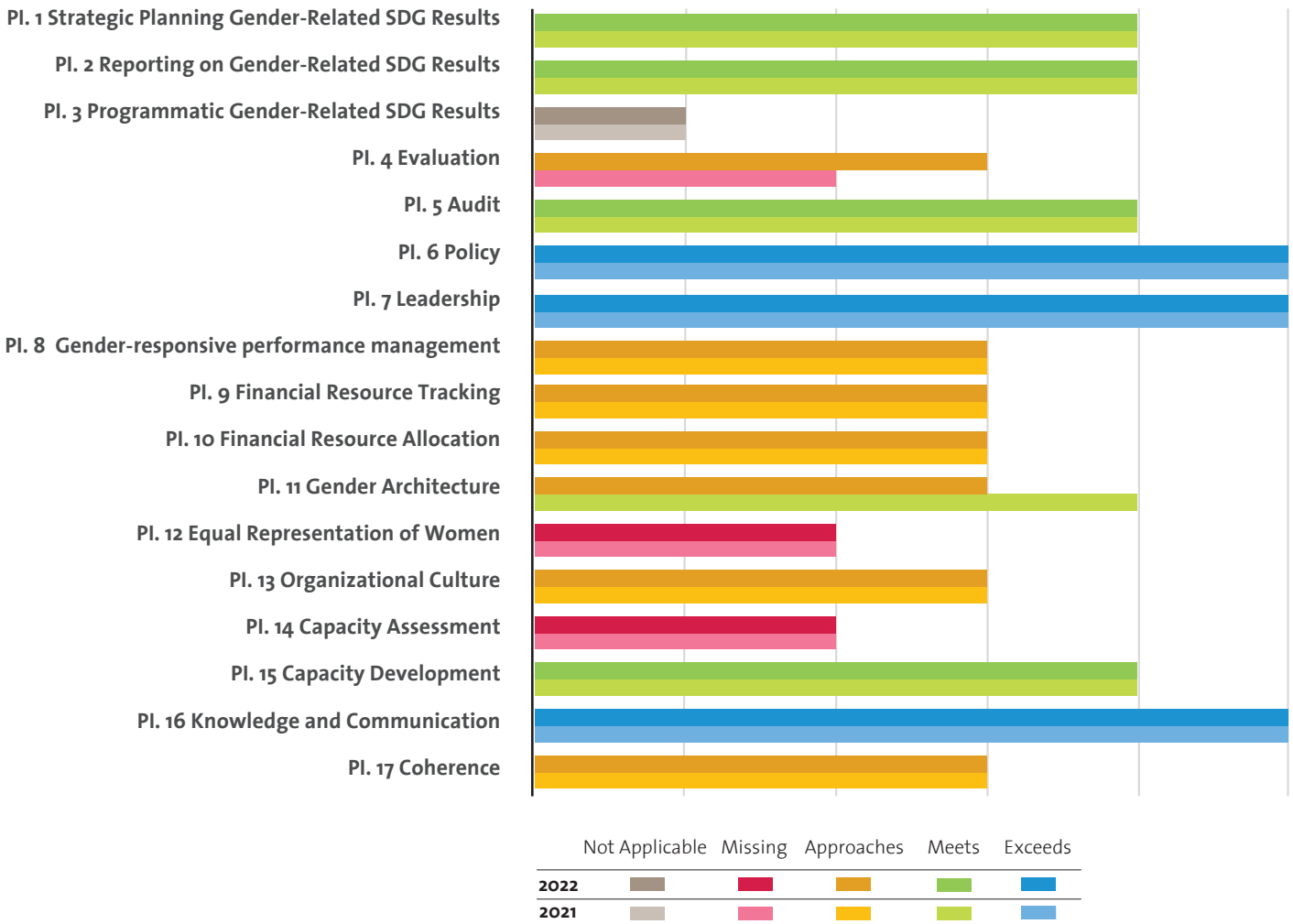

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2022

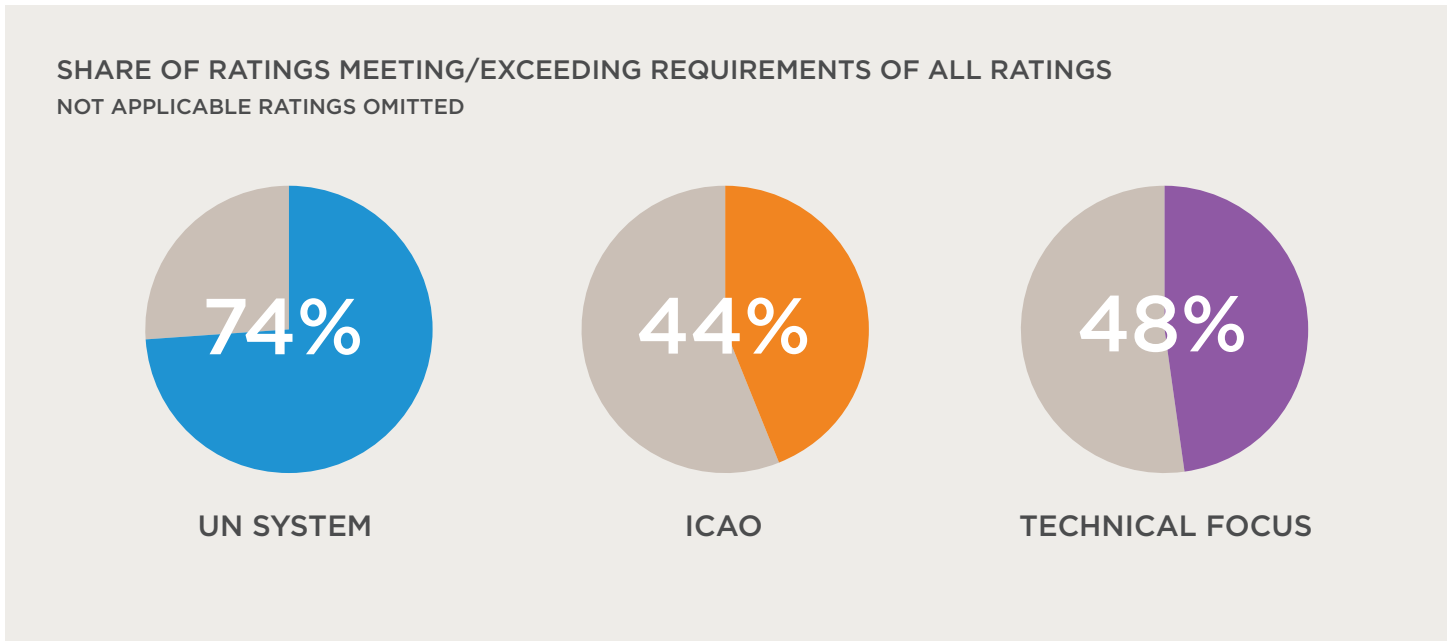
Most significant gains

- In 2022, ICAO exceeded requirements for three indicators and met them for another four indicators.
- ICAO newly approached the indicator requirements related to Evaluation.

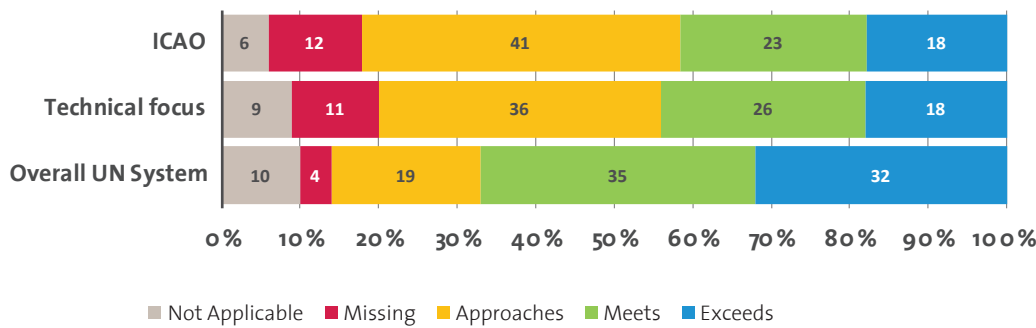
Areas for improvement

- UN Women encourages ICAO to focus on the two indicators missing requirements, Equal representation and Capacity assessment.
- Focused attention in the area of Gender architecture is needed to recapture previous compliance.

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR ICAO

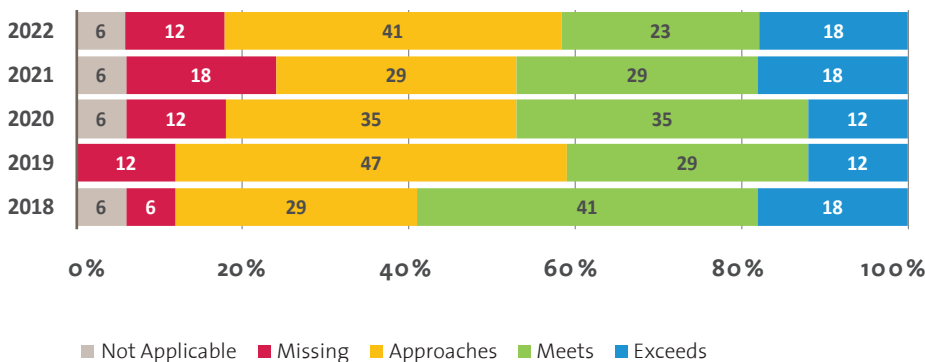


COMPARISON WITH ENTITIES WITH A TECHNICAL FOCUS AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM



In 2022, ICAO met and exceeded requirements for slightly fewer indicators than the average for entities with a technical focus, and trailed the combined performance of the overall UN system.
