

Most significant gains


- In 2022, IOM exceeded the requirements for three indicators and met the requirements for five more indicators.

Areas for improvement


 UN Women encourages IOM to focus on the remaining indicator missing requirements, Programmatic gender-related SDG results, and the eight indicators approaching requirements.
