

 In 2022, OCHA exceeded requirements for five indicators and met them for another seven indicators.


Areas for improvement




COMPARISON WITH SECRETARIAT ENTITIES AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM



In 2022, OCHA met or exceeded a similar share of indicators as the average of the Secretariat entities and UN system as a whole.

Comparatively, OCHA missed more indicator requirements. However, OCHA rated all 17 indicators as applicable to their scope of work.
