
UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2022

- Additionally, OSAA met requirements for the Leadership indicator in 2022.


Areas for improvement

 UN Women encourages OSAA to prioritize Financial resource allocation, the only indicator missing requirements, as well as the five indicators rated as approaching requirements.



COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR OSAA




COMPARISON WITH THE SECRETARIAT AS A WHOLE AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM
