
# UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2022

#### PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2022

## Most significant gains

- In 2022, UNDRR exceeded the requirements for eight indicators and met them for four indicators.
- UNDRR greatly improved its performance by exceeding the requirements of four indicators: Strategic planning gender-related SDG results, Programmatic gender-related SDG results, Policy and Leadership.
- Significantly, UNDRR made progress in the area of Financial resource allocation, improving from missing to approaching requirements.


## Areas for improvement

 UN Women encourages UNDRR to focus efforts on the three remaining indicators approaching requirements, Financial resource allocation, Financial resource tracking, Gender Architecture, and Equal representation of Women.



## COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR UNDRR




#### COMPARISON WITH THE SECRETARIAT AS A WHOLE AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM



In 2022, UNDRR met or exceeded a similar share of indicators than average results of the Secretariat entities and of the UN system as a whole.

Comparatively, UNDRR deemed larger share of indicators as applicable and did not miss requirements for any indicator.

## UNDRR, COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF RATINGS BY YEAR



In 2022, UNDRR met or exceeded the requirements for 70 per cent of all indicators, registering an improvement for 4 indicators in comparison with 2021.
