

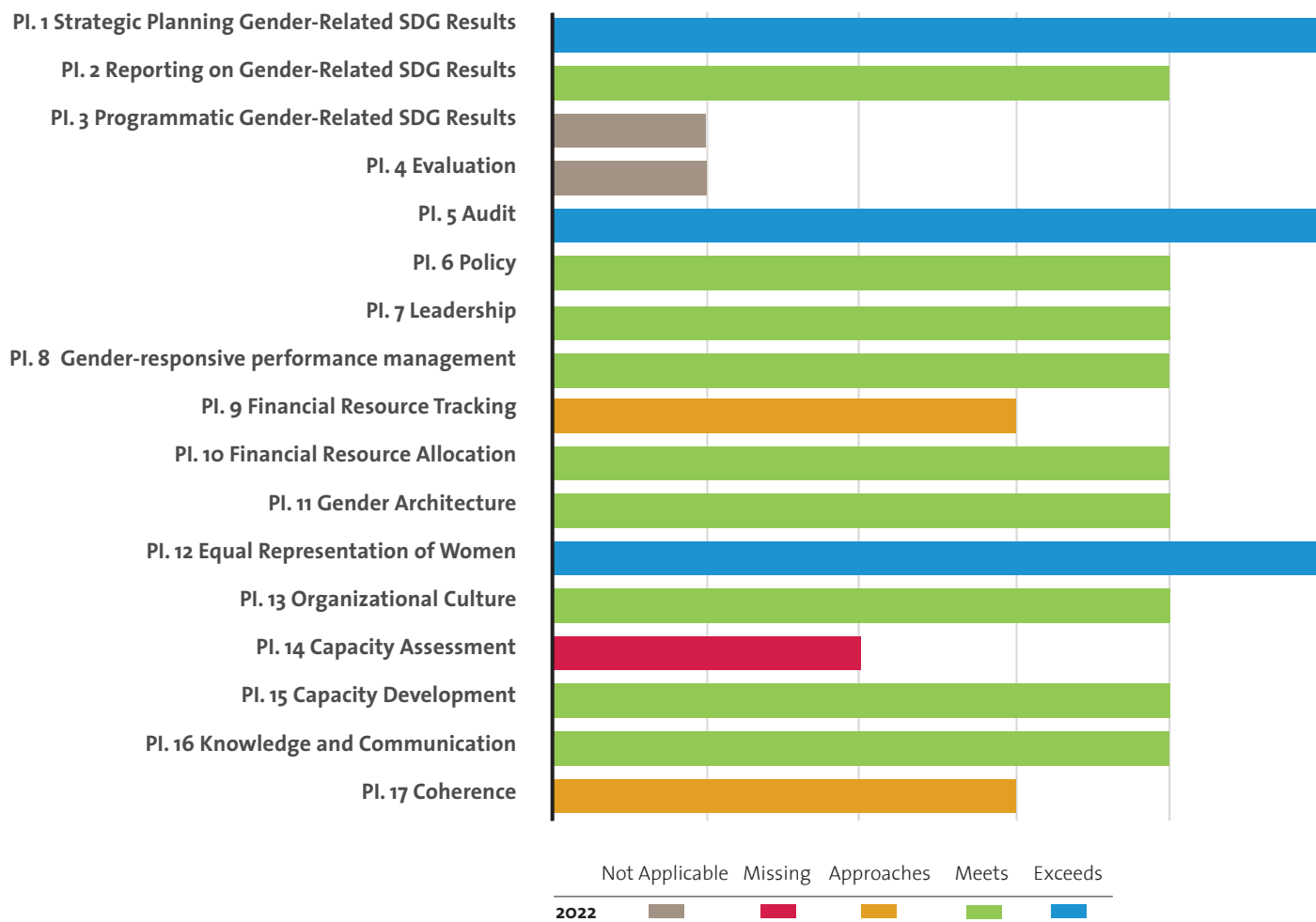

Most significant gains

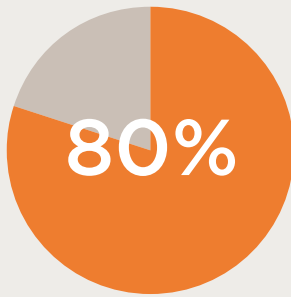
- In 2022, UNIDIR exceeded requirements for three indicators and met them for another nine indicators.

Areas for improvement

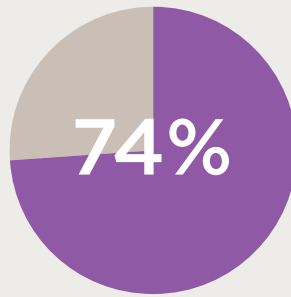
- UN Women encourages UNIDIR to prioritize the only indicator missing requirements, Capacity assessment.

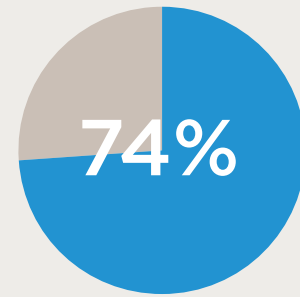

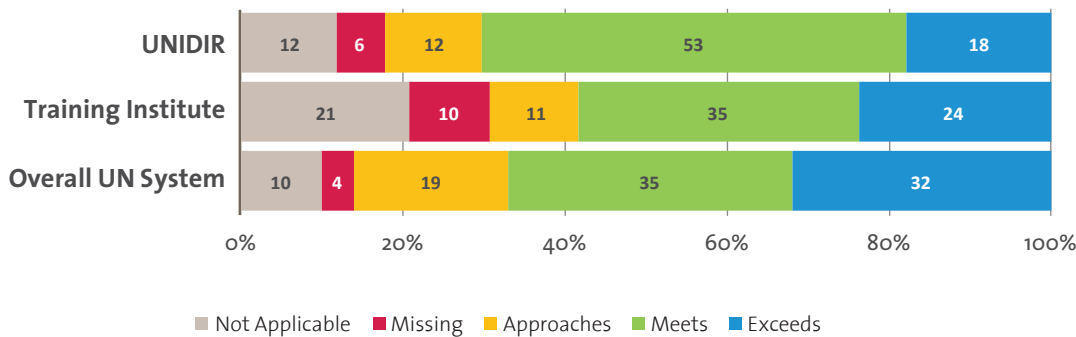

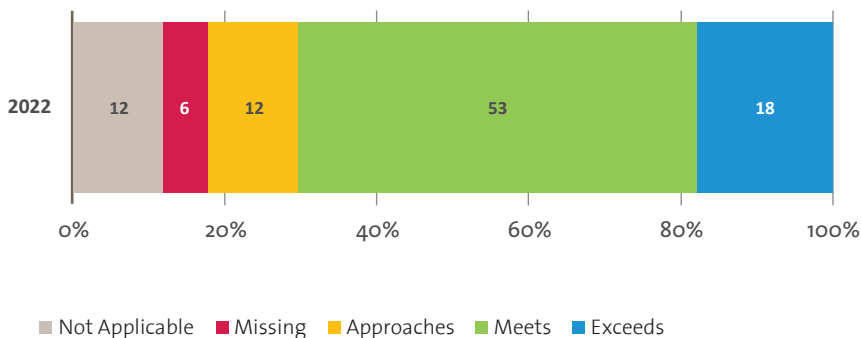
UN SYSTEM
