
UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2022

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2022

Most significant gains

- In 2022, UNOCT exceeded the requirements for four indicators and met the requirements for another eleven indicators.
- Significantly, UNOCT newly exceeded the requirements for the Policy indicator.
- Also of note, UNOCT newly met the requirements for three additional indicators. Strategic Planning and Reporting of gender-related SDG Results and Coherence.


Areas for improvement

 UN Women encourages UNOCT to focus efforts on the two indicators rated as approaching requirements in 2022, Financial resource tracking and Financal resource allocation.



COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR UNOCT




COMPARISON WITH THE SECRETARIAT AS A WHOLE AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM

In 2022, UNOCT achieved its highest UN-SWAP 2.0 performance to date.

UNOCT met or exceeded significantly more indicators this year than in their first three years of reporting, no longer missed requirements of any indicator and deemed all seventeen indicators as applicable to their work.
