

Most significant gains


• In 2022, UNOPS exceeded the requirements for nine indicators and met them for another two indicators, maintaining a strong overall performance.

Areas for improvement


• UN Women encourages UNOPS to focus efforts on the three indicators rated as approaching requirements: Gender architecture, Equal representation of women and Capacity assessment.
