

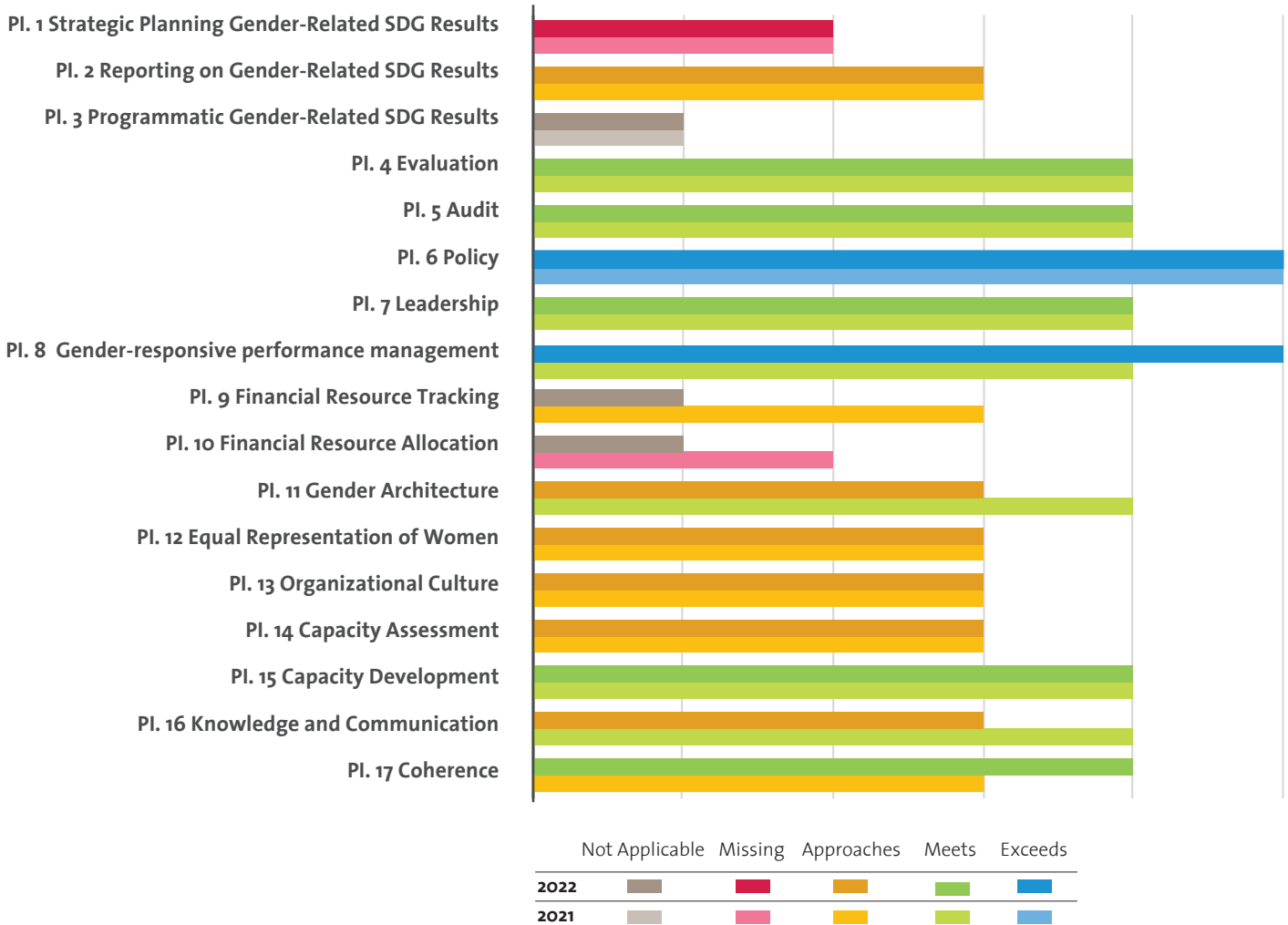

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2022

Most significant gains

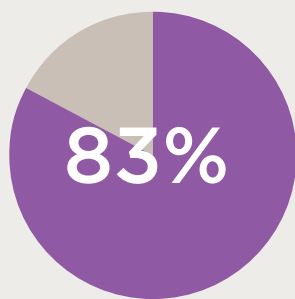
- In 2022, UNRWA exceeded the requirements for two indicator and met the requirements for another five indicators.
- Commendably, UNRWA newly exceeded the requirements for the Gender-responsive performance management.
- Also of note, UNRWA newly met the requirements for the Coherence indicator in 2022.

Areas for improvement

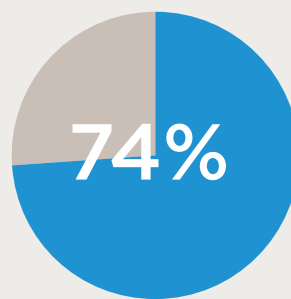
- UN Women encourages UNRWA to focus efforts on the one indicator rated as missing requirements: Strategic Planning Gender-Related SDG Results.
- UN Women also encourages renewed focus on the six indicators rated as approaching requirements, particularly the two indicators that regressed in 2022: Gender architecture and Knowledge and communication.

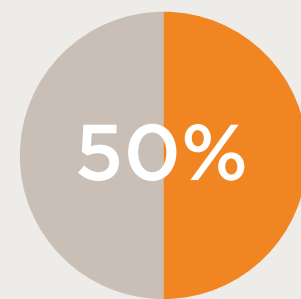
SHARE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS OF ALL RATINGS

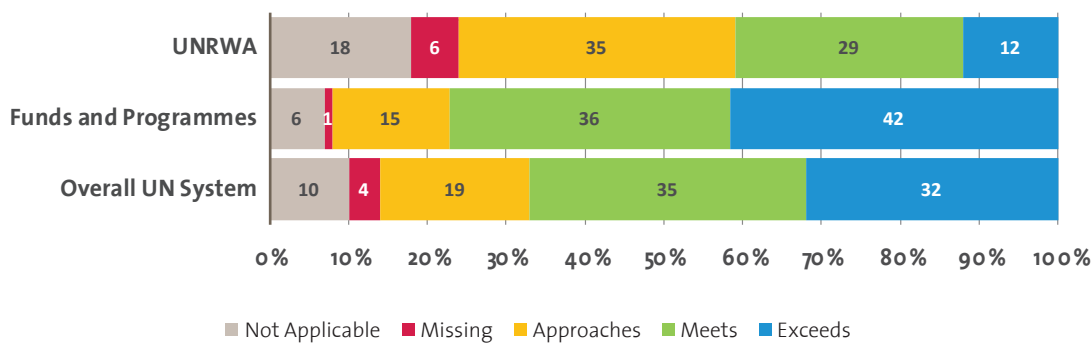

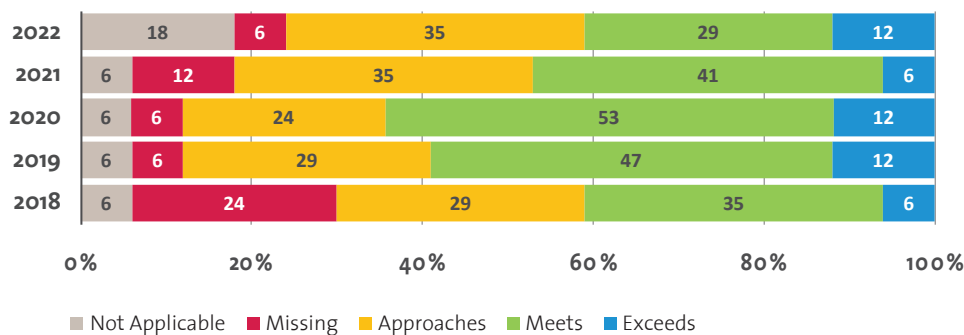
COMPARISON WITH THE FUNDS AND PROGRAMMES AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM



In 2022, UNRWA trailed the average performance of the UN system as a whole, and of the Funds and programmes.

UNRWA also rated significantly more indicators as not applicable to their scope of work than similar entities.

UNRWA, COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF RATINGS BY YEAR



UNRWA met and exceeded a similar share of applicable indicators in 2022 as in 2021, despite a slight decline in performance of two indicators.
