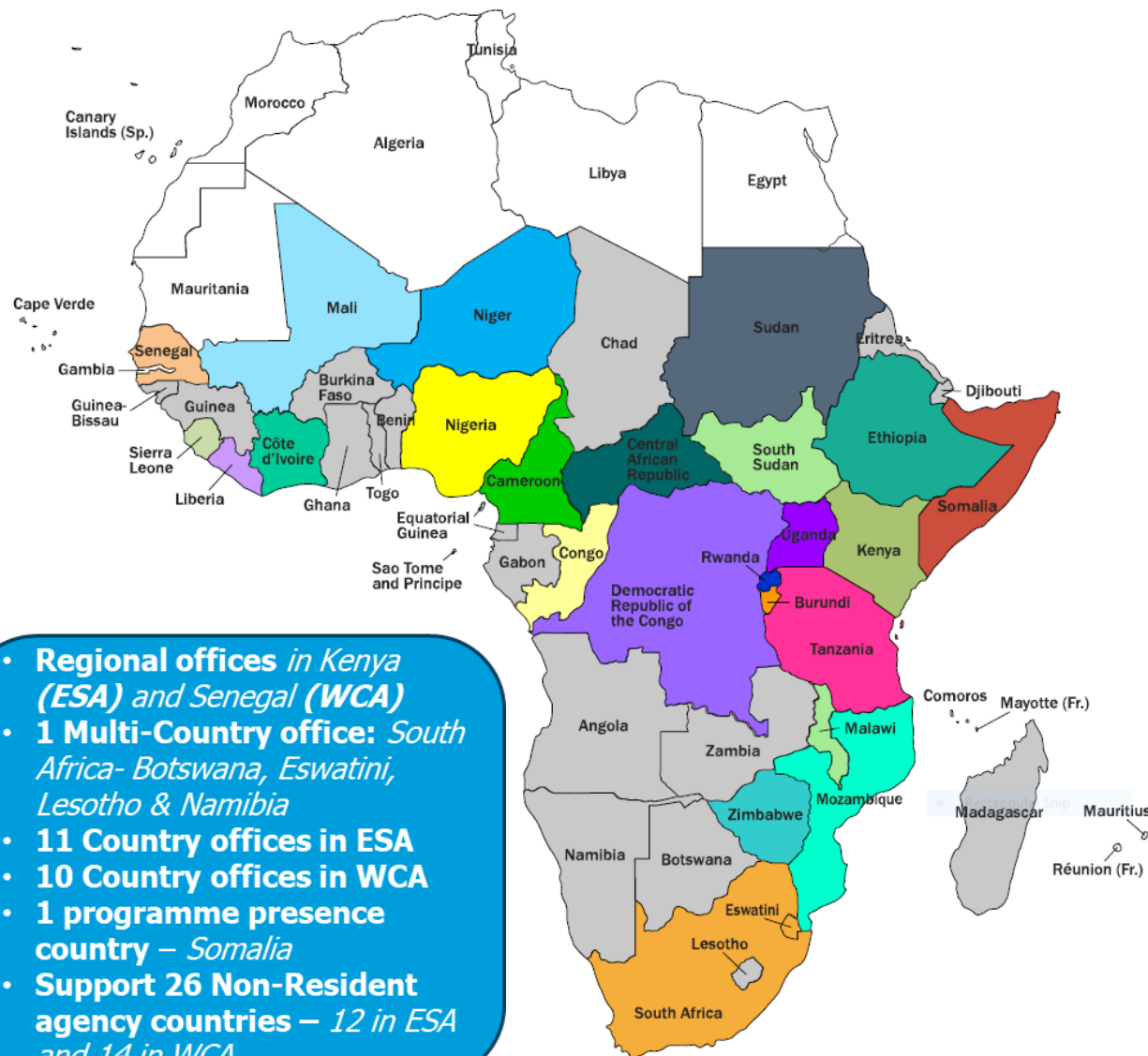

Economic

- Land ownership: <13% women and 36% men
- 2/3 of women are in informal sector
- Labor force participation: 60.9% women & 72.7% men
- Financial inclusion gender gap: 11.3%
- Female smallholder farmers productivity: 20-30% lower

Political

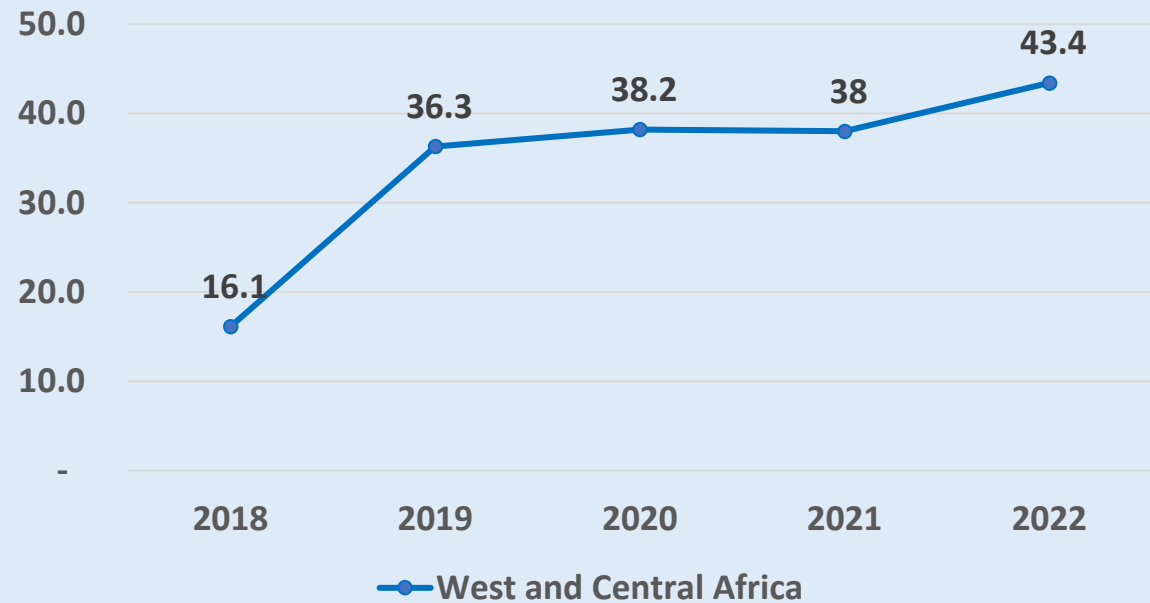
- 13 countries with 30% women in Parliament
- Conflict and state fragility
- Shrinking democratic space
- Coups in West Africa

Social

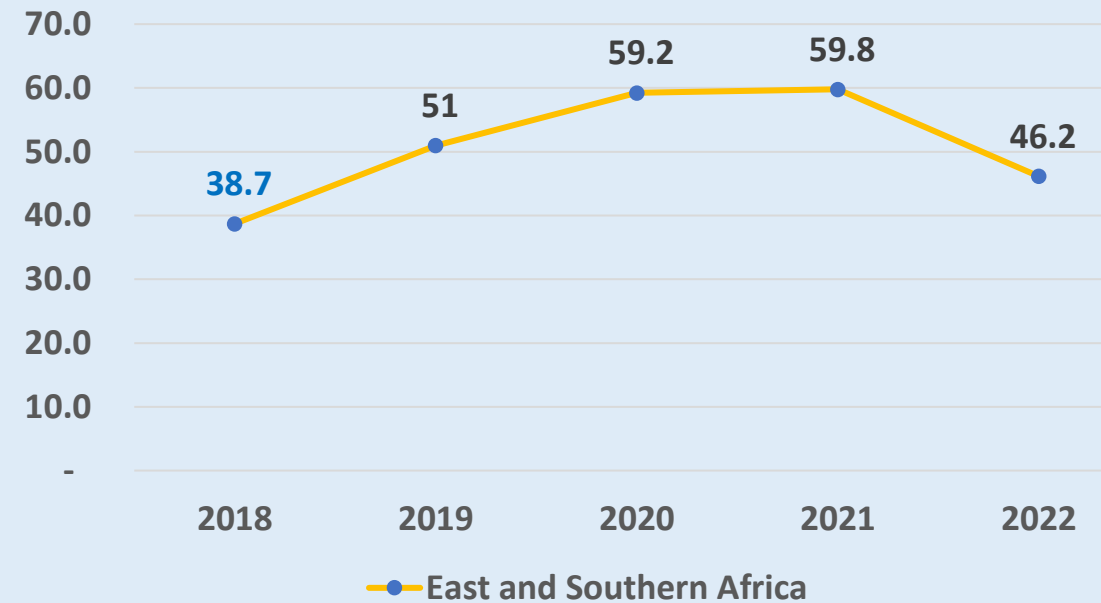
- Natural disasters- Drought, floods & cyclones
- Refugee & humanitarian crisis
- Internal displacement of women & children
- Rate of child marriages has declined but still high
- High FGM rates amongst women and girls aged 15-49

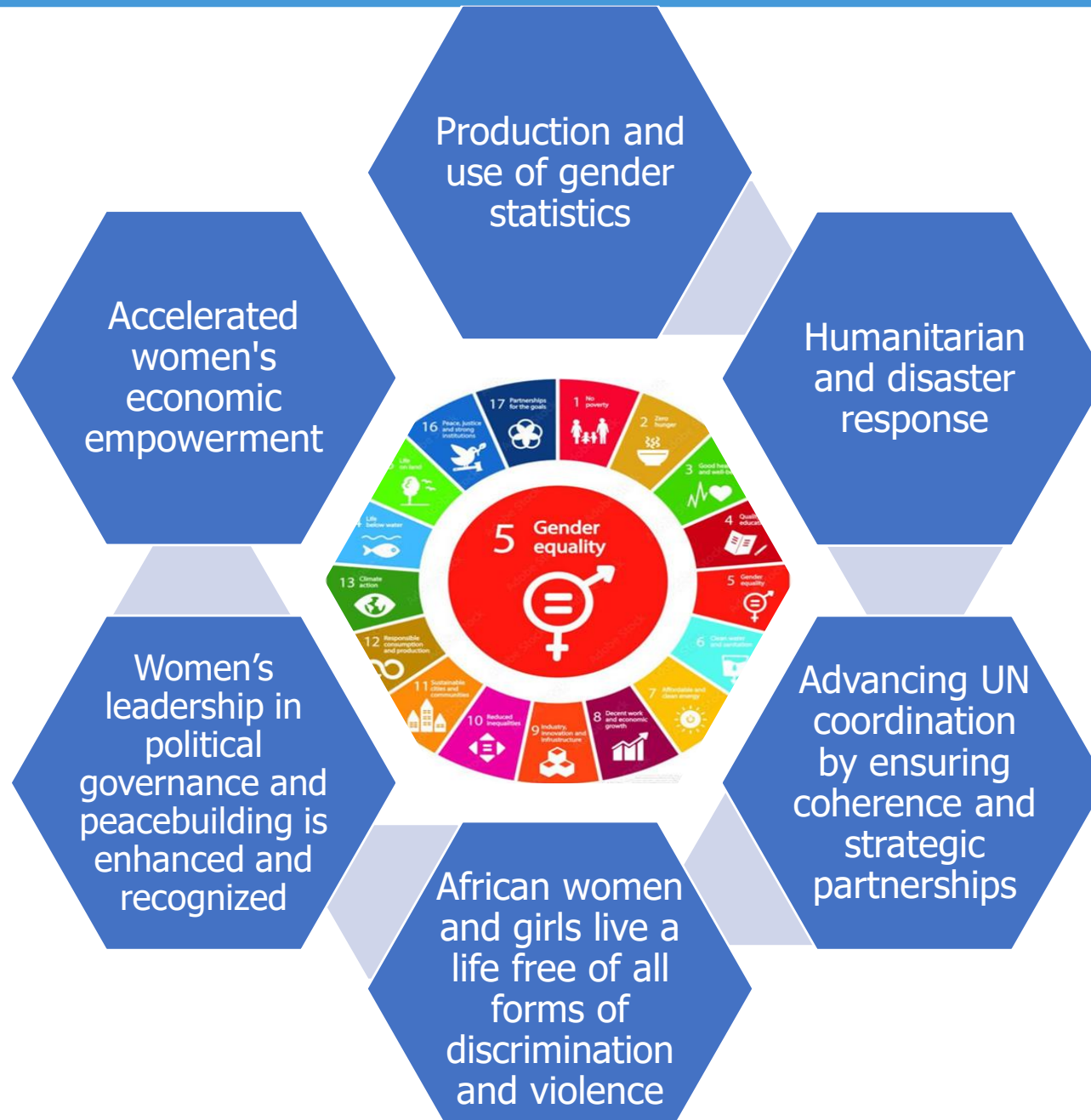
